Cleaning Solutions for a Healthier Home

We are living in a chemical soup, from our environment right down to the safe haven of our homes. Since World War II, more than 80,000 synthetic chemicals have been introduced to our society and 40 million tons are manufactured worldwide; said differently, some of these chemicals are in our food supply, skin care, cleaning products, and lawn care, affecting our health and our planet.

Have you ever wondered why your skin gets irritated after using certain cleaning products, or why your throat is a little sore or you get nasal burning sensations? Chemicals trigger inflammatory responses, which we recognize as heat, swelling, and redness. This occurs when your immune system is under attack -- in the tissues of your face, in your arteries, and in your vital organs. The more poisons we are exposed to, the more inflamed our bodies become.

So, what do we do? Sit around and get scared, or make changes?

In order to be healthy and have beautiful looking skin, begin by making some small changes. Let's first start by editing your cleaning supplies. You don't have to throw away everything. There are some great cleaners out there that are good for the environment... and you!

Some of my favorite products to choose from are Seventh Generation, Bi-o-Kleen, Aubrey Organics, Naturcare, Ecover, Dr. Bronner's, Naturally Yours, Earthrite, BIOFA (natural paint products), Earth Friendly, and AFM (safer building and maintenance products). They can be found online or at health food stores, and now some large supermarket chain stores have them in stock.

Natural products are better, but if you must use chain store cleaners, here are some you are familiar with that are voted safer than their competitors:

- All-purpose cleaner: Mr. Clean Lemon Fresh; Ajax All Purpose Liquid Cleaner Lemon Fresh.
- Air Fresheners: Citrus Magic; Airwick Stick Ups.
- Bathroom Cleaners: Ajax All Purpose Liquid Cleaner Lemon Fresh; Fantastik wipes;
 Spic and Span Pine floor cleaner.
- Bleaches: Clorox 2, Vivid Color Safe Bleach (Naturally Yours Natural Bleach and Softener would be best.)
- Carpet Cleaners: O'Cedar Carpet Science Spot & Stain Remover; Airwick Carpet Fresh (all).
- Cleansers: Mr. Clean Soft Cleanser
- Dishwashing Liquid: Ivory; Palmolive (no dyes)
- Automatic: Shaklee Basic D; Sunlight Powder Dishwashing Detergent.
- Floor Cleaner: Brite, Step-Saver.
- Furniture Polish: Old English Wood Soap; Wood Plus Furniture Polish & Cleaner
- Glass Cleaner: 409 Glass and Surface Cleaner; Mr. Clean Glass and Surface Spray Cleaner.
- Laundry Detergent: All Free and Clear Liquid Laundry Detergent: Ivory Soap Granules.
- Fabric Softener: Arm & Hammer; Bounce Unscented; Shaklee Softer than Soft Fabric Conditioner.

- Stain remover: Shout Liquid; Spray 'n Wash Stain Stick
- Oven Cleaner: Easy-Off Fume Free Oven Cleaner (pump)
- Toilet Bowel Cleaner: Vanish Solid Automatic Toilet Bowl Cleaner

Now let's combat the chemical war with natural cleansers. Here are my home sweet home-made cleaning recipes:

All-Purpose Household Cleaner - What you will need:

Liquid Soap (Dr. Bronner's Castile soap)
White distilled vinegar
Borax
Essential oil
16-oz trigger spray bottle

Mix 2 tbsp. of vinegar with 1 tsp. Borax. Fill rest of bottle with very hot water. Shake well. Add ¼ cup of liquid soap. Add 10 -15 drops of lemon oil or bergamot.

Dish Wash Blend

Fill a 22-oz bottle with castile soap. Add 15 drops of lemon oil, 6 drops of lavender oil, and 6 drops of Bergamot oil.

Natural Soft Scrub
What you will need:
½ cup baking soda
½ cup liquid soap
5 - 10 drops pure antiseptic essential oil (lavender, tea tree, or rosemary)

Place the baking soda in a bowl. Slowly pour in liquid soap, stirring constantly until frosting-like. Add oil.

Bathroom Cleaner

Combine 2 tsp. of Borax, 4 tbsp. of distilled white vinegar, 4 cups of very hot water, and ¼ tsp. of liquid soap. Add a few drops of tea tree oil.

Stain Remover

Get a fresh lemon or lime and baking soda. Wet the stain and pour on the baking soda. Squeeze lemon juice over the stain. Let it set for a few hours. Finish by rubbing off remainder with a sponge.

Glass Cleaner

Get an 8 - oz spray bottle. Fill halfway with vinegar and then add water to fill rest of bottle. Add some lemon oil to the mixture.

Furniture Polish

Fill an 8 - oz squirt bottle with ¾ cup of olive oil, ¼ cup of white vinegar, and ¾ tsp. of lemon oil or food - grade lemon extract. Shake and start dusting.

Floor Cleaner

Fill a bucket with hot water. Add Dr. Bronner's liquid soap and a drop of vinegar. This solution works great on your floors.

Carpet Deodorizer

Combine baking soda, corn starch (equal parts), and 10 drops of lavender oil into a shaker container (use an old empty clean Kraft Parmesan cheese container). Sprinkle on carpet. Let it set for an hour and then vacuum.

Other Cleaning Idea

Peroxide 3% or lemon juice and sunlight makes a great natural bleach. Club Soda is a great emergency spotter for spills on carpet and clothes.

Plants: Nature's Air Purifiers

Are you ready to grow some fresh air in your house?

After all that cleaning, it's time to remove toxins in the air by purchasing some plants. A Boston fern helps to remove air pollutants, especially formaldehyde, and adds humidity to the indoor environment. The Ficus Alii is a large plant that also helps to purify the air and remove chemical vapors. A corn plant prefers bright light but can live in semi-shade. It is an excellent house plant to help remove formaldehyde.

Plants should be placed every 100 yards to do the job of eliminating toxic vapors in your home.

Other Air Purifiers

To further enhance the quality of the air, my family purchased an air purifier by Shaklee, aromatherapy diffuser, soy candles with essential oils (not synthetic fragrance), Salt lamps (health food store), and a Rainbow Home Cleaning System vacuum (uses water instead of bags). Other hydro vacuums that are less expensive to consider are Thane's H20 Vac and Frontgate's Water Filtration Hydro Vacuum.

By the process of eliminating chemicals, we can create the safe-haven home we deserve. The more educated we are the better our choices.

God gave us all these wonderful resources to live the best we can, and, in turn, we should take care of HIS beautiful creations — including ourselves, His masterpieces!

You shall not murder.

Thou Shalt Not Kill

The sanctity of life finds its root in the heart of our loving heavenly Father. As the God and Father of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, HE is not only the giver of life.

HE also is the sustainer of life. HE is, in fact, life! As God, sovereign and eternally existent, HE commanded life in the very act of creation from HIS eternal throne. Because HE breathed HIS life into the nostrils of created man, HE retained the only means by which fallen man could be brought back into HIS sovereign and Holy presence after man had forfeited his special relationship with God. The sin of Adam and Eve precipitated the consequence of sin in every person without exception.

As righteous judge, Holy in every capacity, God could not, in any way, tolerate the sin of man. Spiritual and eternal death is the only way to satisfy God's justice. This is the "wage" of sin Paul speaks of in Romans 6:23. "But God demonstrates HIS own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). The giver of life gave life through HIS Son, the Lord Jesus Christ.

Jesus gave HIS life in full atonement for the redemption of all who would repent of their sin and come to HIM by faith. No wonder Jesus was able to say, "I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly" (John 10:10).

In this <u>commandment</u>, God establishes HIMself as the sole and sovereign giver, sustainer and taker of life. "You shall <u>not</u> murder" was <u>not</u> designed to give HIS children the right to choose. Rather, it was designed to make one thing very clear: Do <u>not</u> kill. Murder is the taking of life! And every life, beginning at conception, is <u>not</u> only given by God, but also taken by God at HIS choosing.

Human life is sacred because God is involved from beginning to end. Of course, there are many who have opinions concerning biblical exceptions. John Calvin, for example, was careful to say that this commandment meant that we must defend the lives of others.

The great commentator Matthew Henry believed this command did not include the taking of life in "lawful" war, the necessary defense of personhood (in a home invasion, for example), and also the death sentence in a proven case of murder.

While there will always be the great need to be loving and sensitive in important matters such as the threat to a mother's life and the violence and criminality of rape and incest, it is tragic to consider the deaths of millions of voiceless and defenseless babies in America since the enactment of Roe vs. Wade. God said, "You shall not kill." Is it not time to take God at HIS word?

The <u>Ten Commandments</u> are <u>not</u> a detached series of instructions. They are a basic unity. They begin in God's heart and are expressed through our hearts. <u>Murder</u> is about a heart problem. Jesus said, "For out of the heart proceed <u>evil</u> thoughts, <u>murders</u>, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies" (<u>Matthew 15:19</u>). The Hebrew verb râtsach has a wide range of meanings, generally describing destructive activity but including "to break," "dash to pieces," and "to slay, <u>kill</u> or <u>murder</u>." Interestingly, the Bible never uses râtsach in conjunction with <u>war</u>.

What the Scriptures do teach is that God's <u>commandment</u> involves three major issues. First, the sovereignty of God. He is the giver, sustainer and taker of all life. Second, the sanctity of life. All people are wonderfully and fearfully made by the hand of God. Third, the significance of every person. There is not one single person ever made that was not made by our God. This unique relationship between creator God and created man is so precious to God that HE gave HIS only Son to die on a cross so that all people can be reconciled to HIM and have peace with HIM (see John 3:16).

It follows that the manner with which we regard life is a direct reflection of our view of God. HE is King of kings and Lord of lords.

HIS position has never changed, and HIS Word remains the one true absolute in our rapidly changing and divided world. God's Word is "a lamp to my feet And a light to my path" (Psalm 119:105).

God always shows us the way. HE shows us the way to salvation through the Lord Jesus Christ, and HE shows us the way through life.

HE knows how difficult it is for us to negotiate our own darkness, and HE knows how confusing the court of public opinion can be. The human heart is sinful by nature and sinful by choice. It follows that not everything a Holy and righteous God has to say about life and death is designed to find agreement with man's propensity to design his world around either his feelings or his popular belief.

God is still God. HIS grace has called us into a right relationship with HIM. HIS love has provided the only means by which we can live in peace and harmony with our maker and with our fellow man. The clarion call to follow Christ is the call to follow HIM in life and in death. We follow HIM in life because HE is life.

We follow HIM in death because HE conquered sin and death and the grave. HIS life is our life. "And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in HIS Son. He who has the Son has life"! (1 John 5:11 - 12).

10 Tips for Getting a Good Night's Rest

CBN.com - 1. Adhere to the three environmental basics of good sleep. First, be sure your room is as dark as you can get it. This may mean additional blinds, blackout curtains or a sleeping mask. Secondly, the room must be quiet.

Additional drapes or a white noise sound equalizer may help. Thirdly, the room needs to be cool. The temperature should be 68 degrees or less.

- 2. Poor sleep is often a symptom of anxiety, worry, obsession, guilt, unresolved anger, depression and many other emotional and spiritual problems. Be sure that you are working to resolve any issues or heal any wounds that leave you tossing and turning. A vital part of the treatment of these problems must be surrendering them to God. Allow HIM to handle and heal what is beyond your abilities.
- 3. Poor sleep often results from a low serotonin level. Serotonin may be replenished through eating foods that promote serotonin production. Turkey, dairy products, and bananas are examples of such foods. Secondly, there are supplements such as 5HTP that may be helpful.
 - Others experience serotonin depletion due to a genetic disorder, which may require medication. Don't eat protein late at night. It can keep you awake. Eat a light carbohydrate snack an hour or two before bedtime, like a muffin, to get the tryptophan you ate earlier in the day into your brain.
- 4. After dinner, take a walk or do some type of exercise, but remember to complete these at least 3 hours before bedtime. Exercise too close to bedtime can be over stimulating. Early exercise can help you relax.
- 5. Just before you are ready to retire, drink a half-cup of herb tea that contains ingredients like Valerian or chamomile.
- 6. Alter what you consume. Don't drink (or eat) anything with caffeine past noon. Chocolate, tea, coffee, colas, and other caffeine-laden drinks must not be consumed in the afternoon. Check the ingredients of anything you ingest to insure caffeine, ephedra, or other stimulants are absent.
- 7. Adequate sunlight is needed during the day to regulate proper sleep cycles. If you have a seasonal affective disorder, you may need a light box to add additional light during the day. You can learn about these light sources at Sun Box at (800) 548-3968.
- 8. If you're struggling with sleep, don't get in bed to watch television. If you cannot sleep, go into another room and read until you are sleepy. Do not get up and watch television because the color and light will be too stimulating to the brain.
- 9. If you awaken in the middle of the night, do not turn on a light or look to see what time it is. Both of these can stimulate the brain out of its sleep mode.

Lay there and see if you fall back to sleep. If you do not fall back to sleep, get up, go into another room and read under a soft light until you feel sleepy. Return to bed and lay there, resting the remainder of the night, even if you do not sleep. Most likely, you will be sleeping on and off and not be aware of it. These brief awakenings are also great times for communion with God.

10. Try to develop a routine that works and stick to it. Go to bed at the same time each night and wake up at the same time.

Depression Doesn't Have to Be a Dirty Word

In our popular culture, depression is deemed a dirty word. Many of us are ashamed to acknowledge to ourselves and to others that we can't muster enough strength to get out of bed in the morning, wash our hair or clean the house.

Society is **not** a help either. Instagram, Pinterest, Facebook and other social media channels remind us that we're supposed to have it all together. The churches do the same. Instead of being open about **depression** in the church we're ashamed it's our fault or even worse, it's our sin. Sin can fuel **depression** for sure, take a look at King David's life, but it's used as an excuse to **not** deal with an <u>illness that impacts an estimated 300 million people</u> worldwide.

Whether we're suffering from a chemical imbalance or dealing with emotions from a tragedy, we need to address depression in our Christian communities.

However, it begins with you. You Need to Do Your Part

I've dealt with anxiety and depression for years, but would not seek help, until it really manifested and began to impact daily living. I thought it would go away eventually but hiding the struggle was hindering my life, until I exposed it by talking about it. The church is full of people grappling with depression every Sunday.

Even our pastors and leaders struggle with depression, because after all, we're still human. What if one person shared their story and struggle? Others would follow and take the risk themselves. Be honest with yourself, God and others.

Seek the Lord

We need to take a step back by seeking the Lord. This seems elementary, but it's easy to get off course when dealing with mental illness. Stuffing the pain with work, social media, food, overspending or any other vice prevents us from working through our pain. Alli Worthington, author of the devotional, The Year of Living Happy: Finding Contentment and Connection in a Crazy World, says we erroneously believe if we have more of this or that, we won't feel as sad or as empty.

She writes, "The only way we find true happiness in life is following the Lord. Our happiness can be increased just by the small daily decisions we make. Our interactions with other people, how much gratitude we have in our lives and our thought patterns...we really need to train our thoughts and renew our minds to make sure that we are internally talking to ourselves in the same way God wants us to." Like Jesus and Worthington suggested, seek the Kingdom first (Mathew 6:33).

Talk to a Trusted Friend

Jesus disclosed to others regarding HIS mission and shared HIS pain with the Father at the cross when HE felt forsaken.

We've accepted depression as feebleness, and who wants to look weak? If Jesus, the Son of God, poured HIS heart out, and laid down HIS pride, so can you. You can't steer this vessel unaided, reach out to someone. Put on courage today and talk to friends, a therapist or to a family physician.

Encourage Yourself

Take it easy, I am **not** advocating talking out loud at the office but instead recite Scriptures to yourself that encourage you. Use prompts on your iPhone, tape reminders in your car of who you are in Christ. Remember you're the head, **not** the tail. Confess favor over daily tasks, confess favor with God, with people and tap into the living power residing in you. Reflect on what God has done for you in the past, will HE **not** come through now?

"You have turned my mourning into joyful dancing. You have taken away my clothes of mourning and clothed me with joy." Psalm 30:11 (NLT)

Clinical depression or chronic despair spawned from life events can't always be avoided, but we can make it easier by being honest with ourselves, God, and exposing the indignity surrounding depression.

"For the Lord God will help me; therefore, shall I not be confounded: therefore, I set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be ashamed." Isaiah 50:7, (KJV)





Summary of **Divorce** and Remarriage Points **Not** Seen By Legalists

- 1. Not all marriages are put together by God (Joshua 23:12 13, Ezra Ch. 9:13 14, & 10:2 3, 10 13)... not to mention "David and Bathsheba or Samson and Delilah"
- 2. There are many unequally yoked marriages that God Hates even MORE than divorce (Exodus 34:14, 16, Deuteronomy 7:3-4, Deuteronomy 13:6 10, 1 Kings 11:1 4)
- 3. Jesus Christ is the same, yesterday, today, and forever (Hebrews 13:8)
- 4. This means that God STILL commands us to separate from the disobedient and wicked... (Psalms 1:1, 26:5, Psalms 101:4, 7 8, 119:113, 115, 118, Proverbs 13:20, 19:19, 22:10, 22:24 25, 23:9, Matthew 7:6, 10:34 38, 18:17, Mark 3:25, 8:22, 10:14, 12:30, Romans 1:32, Romans 16:17, 1 Corinthians 5:11 12, 1 Corinthians 15:33,

- 2 Corinthians <u>6:14</u> 17, Ephesians 5:3 7, <u>5:11</u> 14, 2 Timothy 3:1-5, Tit <u>3:10</u> 11, Hebrews 1:8 9, 1 Timothy <u>5:22</u>, 2 John <u>1:11</u>, Rev 18:4)
- 5. NONE of the above commands are abolished by the temporary institution called "marriage"
- 6. Jesus' teaching on divorce was specifically to a Jewish audience (Just as each) of HIS messages to the 7 churches in Revelation 2 3 were specific to each church in accordance to THEIR unique issues and sins, so too was HIS teaching in the Gospels on divorce specific to Jews who were in a divorce crisis, divorcing for any foolish reason, because their hearts were hard. (Matthew 19:8)
- 7. Even still, Jesus did not fail to give this concession to those Jews who were quick to divorce, saying, "Except for Adultery" regarding remarriage in Matthew 19:9
- 8. Jesus intentionally chose a woman who was divorced and remarried FIVE times to evangelize an entire town. Never once did he say to her, "God Hates divorce or you can never marry again, or you are going to hell because you remarried FIVE TIMES!" (John 4:1 25)
- 4. The same word used in 1 Corinthians 7:39 to describe the widow who is no longer "bound", and thus free to remarry is the exact same word used in the phrase "no longer bound" in 1 Corinthians 7:15, to describe the new condition of the believing spouse who has been left by a believing spouse.
- 5. The greater principle in the NEW Covenant than "physical death" which can separate a marriage, is "spiritual death".

Many people are indeed in marriages, living with spiritually dead people who have once and for all rejected Christ and that death is slowly spreading to the "living spouse", which is EXACTLY why God placed all the commands listed above to SEPARATE Romans the disobedient...

HE is trying to preserve a Holy uncontaminated remnant. This cannot be done when a person is living with a "dead body" yoking their light to the darkness. Passages showing Spiritual death in Scripture: (Matthew 8:22, 23:27, John 5:24, 6:63, 12:40, Romans 7:10, 8:2, 8:6, Ephesians 2:1, 2:5, Col 2:13, Jam 1:15, 2:26, 1 Timothy 5:6, Rev 3:1)

- 11. Anyone who has doubts about divorce or remarriage should NOT move forward in either, until you have heard clearly from the Lord and can move forward by faith. Anything not done in faith (with doubt) is sin. Romans 14:23
- 12. Only God, by HIS Holy Spirit can give Revelation on the deep things and matters of HIS heart on subjects like this. God reveals them to Babes but hides them from the clever, the proud, the legalistic and the "wise and learned". Matthew 11:25 26

Luke 7:33 -3 5 NIV [33] For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine, and you say, 'He has a demon.' [34] The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and you say, 'Here is a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and "sinners." ' [[Michael Chriswell came and remarried after his first wife had an affair and then years later divorced him for serving God rather than money, and you say, 'Here is a lawbreaker and adulterer.' [] [35] But wisdom is proved right by all her children."

Praying in the **Spirit** aka speaking in Tongues

Praying in Tongues is a sign to the unbelievers. 1 Corinthians 14:21 - 22 Don't interrupt church with it unless you have an interpreter. 1 Corinthians 14:27 - 28 Know, that many people think that it is an earthly language, but it is a Heavenly Language that some may HEAR in THEIR language. Edifies the speaker's spirit without interpretation. With private interpretation this gift also edifies one's understanding.
- 3) Ministerial Tongues (with Interpretation, public use) 1 Corinthians 14:5 Language is unknown to the Speaker and Unknown to the hearer, but interpretation is given to the speaker or another standing by so that all that hear (understand) and be edified.
- 4) Tongues for Deep Intercessional groaning that words cannot express Romans 8:26 Language is unknown to the speaker and unknown to the hearer. When this type of tongues comes upon a person it comes with tremendous power to bring breakthrough or spiritual birthing of things. Galatians 4:19 Mark 16:15 20 15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

It was obeying its Creator! There was not a doubt in my mind as to what had occurred. Jesus made my back straight!!!! I give all the praise and glory to God! HE is so good! As Amy Grant would say, "I can't explain it any other way, but God, truly God, truly God."

There is a physical Therapist assistant and another nurse on our team who also verified that the alignment was straight. I wish I could show you the huge smile on my face as I type this! God is so good and HIS love endures forever! I was covered by HIS love tonight!" - Danielle Contarino





8 Keys to Knowing God's Will For Your Life

When I was a young man, I seemed to continually wrestle with knowing God's will for my life. I wanted more than anything to follow HIS plan. Interestingly, now that I'm "old" (currently 47 - years - old), I still wrestle with doing HIS will in my life. I have come to learn that this is not just something that a young person does early in life; it is a lifelong pursuit in order to stay in the exact center of HIS plan and to trust in it!

So, then, how can we know God's plan for our lives?

Over the past twenty - five years that I have been in ministry, I have discovered eight vital keys to knowing God's will and plan for your life. Here they are:

1) Walk with God.

For starters, if you are interested in knowing God's plan for your life, then you must learn to walk with God. You need to develop a relationship with HIM. Christianity is all about relationship rather than just religion.

And so, you must cultivate your relationship with God. You must seek to know HIM and not just seek to know about HIM.

You will cultivate that relationship best by spending time in HIS Word, taking time for prayer, and taking every opportunity you can to be involved in church and small group Bible study opportunities. When you seek these disciplines in your life, God will begin the first steps to revealing HIS plan to you. Proverbs 3:5 - 6

⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean **not** on your own understanding; ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge HIM, and HE shall direct your paths.

2) Surrender your will to God's.

Many times, when we say we are seeking God's will, what we are really wanting to say to God is this: "OK, God, here's what I'm planning to do. Now I need you to rubber stamp this, all right?" I must tell you that this is not really effective in finding HIS true will.

Before God will begin to reveal HIS will to you, you must be committed to doing whatever it is that HE desires for you to do. God will likely be slow to show you HIS plan if HE knows you will likely not do that plan anyway. Romans 12:1 - 2

¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, Holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Jesus was willing to die for us, so shouldn't we be willing to live for HIM?

When we surrender to HIM, that is when HE really begins to direct our steps.

3) Obey what you already know to be God's Will.

Many people seem to want to know what God's plan is for their lives, but they overlook the fact that 98% of HIS will is already delineated carefully through HIS Word. God is very clear about many, many aspects of HIS will. For instance, it is clearly HIS plan that we abstain from sexual immorality (1 Thessalonians 4:3).

If we do not obey the things that God has shown us clearly to be HIS will, why would we think HE would reveal any further information regarding HIS plan for our lives?

Obedience is an important first step.

4) Seek Godly input.

One key component to finding God's will is to seek the input of godly advisors in your life. If you don't currently have 3 to 4 Godly mentors, then I would highly recommend that you seek them out right away.

Think of it this way: you should understand that you are basically a composite of the five people you spend the most time with. So, then, it is vital that you choose those three to five people well. If you choose to surround yourself with godly advisors, they will be instrumental in helping you discern God's plan for your life. But if you surround yourself with people who are far from God, your hope of finding HIS best for your life will be greatly diminished. Proverbs 11:14

Where there is **no** counsel, the people fall; but in the multitude of counselors there https://goinswriter.com/tips-writing-book/e is safety.

The church is designed to help you greatly with this. I would encourage you to be in Church every single time the doors are opened. The more you involve yourself with a community of believers, the greater your chances will be of finding godly men and women who can help you discern God's will.

5) Pay attention to how God has wired you.

God has created you to fulfill a specific role in this world. There is **no** one else who can achieve completely what God has purposely created you to do.

The Apostle Peter gives us this admonition: 1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

God has gifted every one of us to perform a special mission for which we alone were created. How amazing is that? Wow!

So, when you seek to discover God's will for your life, pay attention to how HE has gifted you. HIS plan for you will always be directly related to the gifts that HE has bestowed upon you. The great news is that you will automatically be good at whatever it is that HE has called you to do!

6) Listen to God's Spirit.

I experienced a major turning point in my own prayer life when I learned simply to shut up while I was praying. That may sound odd to you, and it seemed odd to me at first.

You see, I used to do all the talking when I prayed to God. But then, several years ago, I read Bill Hybel's book, "Too Busy Not to Pray". That book completely changed the way I approached God through prayer. Since reading that book, I have added a significant component to my prayer life: listening. I take time to listen to what God might have to say to me.

Practically, the way I go about this is to bring a notepad with me when I sit down to pray. Then I write at the top of several page things like the following:



- "What is the next step in my ministry?"
- "What is the next step for my family?"
- "What is the next step for my marriage?"
- "What is the next step in my education?"
- "What is the next step in my finances?"

During my prayer time, I meditate on questions such as the above. Often, God will start flooding my heart with ideas and information regarding one or more of those questions. I write as fast as I can as HE speaks to my heart. What a glorious experience that is to sense HIS Spirit on me, guiding my thoughts and words.

Through experiences like this, HE has shown me many times with great clarity what HIS will is for my life. I long for those experiences when HE speaks to me like that. Those times are truly life changing. <u>John 10:27</u>

My sheep hear MY voice, and I know them, and they follow ME. (Do YOU hear?)

²⁷) Listen to your heart.

In addition to listening to the Spirit, I also recommend listening to your heart. To understand my point here, consider the following passage: Psalms 37:4 - 5

⁴ Delight yourself also in the LORD, and HER shall give you the desires of your heart. ⁵ Commit your way to the LORD, trust also in HIM, and HE shall bring it to pass. (NKJV)

I love this passage, because it shows me that, when I am walking with the Lord, HE will actually let me do many really cool things that I actually love to do! When you are close to HIM, HE actually begins to shape your desires so that you desire the things that HE has already called you to do.

So then, HIS plan actually becomes a super-exciting adventure. I always have the most fun in life when I am doing God's will. And that is because HE shapes my personal "wanter" to want to do the things for which HE has actually created me.

8) Take a look at your circumstances.

God often clearly demonstrates HIS plan for our lives by lining up circumstances in obvious ways. And HE also shows us what HIS will is **NOT** for us to do in that same way. It is **not** HIS will for you to take the job that is **not** offered to you. If you are 5' 6" tall and weigh 125 lbs., it is **not** likely that God has created you to play professional football.

Over the years, I have discovered that God is pretty good at opening and closing doors. HE even did that for the Apostle Paul and his enterouge in Acts. Take a look at this passage: Acts 16:6-10

- ⁶Now when they had gone through Phrygia and the region of Galatia, they were forbidden by the Holy Spirit to preach the word in Asia.
- ⁷ After they had come to Mysia, they tried to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit did not permit them.
 - ⁸ So passing by Mysia, they came down to Troas.
- ⁹ And a vision appeared to Paul in the night. A man of Macedonia stood and pleaded with him, saying, "Come over to Macedonia and help us."
- ¹⁰ Now after he had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go to Macedonia, concluding that the Lord had called us to preach the gospel to them.

So, even Paul had to face closed doors in his ministry. God often uses closed doors to show us clearly what HE does NOT want us to do.

And HE also uses open doors at times to show us what HE DOES want us to do. Of course, this does not mean that every open door is definitely God's plan, but it does help to give you some basic direction.

A Closing Thought:

The next time you begin to ponder God's plan for your life, I would encourage you to mull over the above eight keys. Use these principles to help you to hone in on HIS plan. And when you seek HIS will earnestly, you will find it!

The wonderful benefit to be a New Testament Christian is that God has added a "want to" to the "have to" aspect of HIS commands. The Holy Spirit dwelling within us convicts, prompts, and inspires a *desire* to follow God wholeheartedly.

Common Law Marriage Myths

People often talk about common law marriage as though it is some sort of loophole to get around the traditional model of marriage. Myths and misinformation abound. From theories about saving on taxes to avoiding divorce, people have come up with countless ideas over the years. However, the truth could not be clearer. Effective January 1, 2017, Alabama outlawed common law marriage. Period.

See the Alabama Code, Section 30-1-20, which states: "No common-law marriage may be entered into in this state on or after January 1, 2017." However, the law also states that "an otherwise valid common-law marriage entered into before January 1, 2017, shall continue to be valid in this state."

Nevertheless, Alabama still honors existing common law marriages that were validly created prior to January 1, 2017, and the state still honors marriages of those with valid common law marriages in other states, provided they were valid and legal in the state where obtained. So, it is worth looking at some of the most common myths that here have popped up over the years.

You Just Have to Live Together for Seven Years

It is hard to say where this myth came up because there is nothing in Alabama law that creates a magic number for the amount of time you need to live with someone to create a common law marriage. Even in states that still allow common law marriage, it is more complicated than just residing together. Otherwise, roommates would have to be very careful.

It is Automatic

Nope. Again, this is a complete myth. Just residing together or using another person's last name is rarely enough to satisfy a state's common law marriage requirements. Only a <u>few remaining states</u> allow common law marriage, and they all are quickly eliminating these informal arrangements, just as Alabama did this year. Even in states that still do, like South Carolina, you have to get a court to recognize it for many purposes. Nothing is automatic. Otherwise, the law would effectively force people into marriage without their own consent. This would be absurd.

The Woman has to Use the Man's Last Name on a Legal Document

Wrong again. It is important to think through exactly how this would affect people. If true, it means a woman could impose marriage on a man without his consent or even knowledge. The law does not allow that. Not to mention, following the decision in Obergefell v. Hodges, it would likely be unconstitutional to make common law marriage legal based on a gender - based action.

The Man Must Declare the Woman as His Wife Publicly

Again, this is **not** true for many of the same reasons as the last one. If **true**, it means a man could just make a woman his wife by virtue of his declaration. Both people have holding themselves out publicly as being married, however, generally does fulfill one of the required elements to prove the existence of a common law marriage.

We Do Not Need a Divorce

Here is the real question. The truth is that common law marriages are not a shortcut or loophole. They are still legal arrangements that require dissolution upon breakdown. Just like a business or major contract, if there is a breakdown that requires two people to separate their assets, debts, custody of children, and real estate, then a family court will be involved.

If two people are married in a common law state, such as South Carolina or Texas, and you later move to Alabama, you will still require a divorce in order to legally sever the marital bonds. Physical separation does not alter your rights or obligations, and there's no such thing as a "common law divorce." What Is a "Common Law" Marriage?

A marriage is the union between two people. Typically, state laws require a ceremony and official documentation to recognize a marriage. However, a few states still allow a common law marriage, or an automatic marriage between two people who co - habitate for an extended period of time. If you have questions about the available marriage options in your state, it's important to know what determines a common law marriage.

Although some states do not allow <u>common law marriages</u>, they will still recognize common law marriages that occurred in other states as valid. For <u>example</u>, Colorado allows common law marriages, but California does <u>not</u>.

If a couple lives in California for twenty years, co-habitates the entire time, and considers themselves married, the state will still **not** recognize the couple as married without an official marriage license and ceremony.

However, if the couple lived in Colorado long enough to qualify as married under common law, California would recognize their marriage as valid if the couple moved from Colorado to California.

ELEMENTS OF A COMMON LAW MARRIAGE

If you are wondering whether you and your partner qualify as a common law marriage, there are several factors that determine a common law marriage:

Most states require that a common law marriage take place between two heterosexual partners that resides together in a state that recognizes common law marriages.

However, the Supreme Court ruling that allowed same-sex marriages in all 50 states may influence some states' guidelines concerning this law in specific circumstances. Generally, two same-sex platonic roommates could not qualify for a common law marriage since they would not meet the criteria of an intimate relationship. Same - sex couples can simply apply for an official marriage if desired and not bother with common law distinction.

The length of time the couple has co - habitated also influences common law marriage determinations. No state places an exact time limit, such as co - habitating for seven years or ten years, before qualifying for a common law marriage. Instead, judges use individual discretion and factors in the length of cohabitation on a case-by-case basis.

The couple must hold itself out to the public as a married couple, such as consistently referring to one another as "husband" and "wife" and filing joint tax returns.

Some co - habitating couples may **not** wish to be married under common law. If so, they should file a "Living Together Statement" with the court to make their intentions clear and avoid an unwanted designation of common law marriage.

Name changes are **not** a requirement for a common law marriage or any other type of marriage. Ultimately, any person can apply for a name change for any reason or **no** particular reason at all and make it official by filing the appropriate paperwork with the court. However, many states recognize name changes without official documentation. In theory, it is possible in most states to change your name through usage only.

DRAWBACKS TO COMMON LAW MARRIAGES IN 2019

Despite the apparent convenience and other benefits of a common law marriage, there are several distinct disadvantages. Primarily, a common law marriage does **not** create a presumption that the marriage officially existed. There is **no** official record of the marriage on the public record.

This can also create problems when the relationship ends. Since there is **no** record of a common law marriage officially on the public record, there is **no** set process for determining division of assets or community property that would exist in an official marriage. In the event of a breakup, one of the partners could have nothing left and **no** grounds for legal recourse.

Another issue facing common law marriages is survivorship benefits. If your partner dies in a common law marriage, you have no legal claim on his or her property as you would in an official marriage. COMMON LAW MARRIAGE IN COLORADO

In Colorado, a common law marriage is one in which the couple lives together and holds themselves out to friends, family and the community as married, but never go through a formal ceremony or get a marriage license. In Colorado, a common law marriage requires that you live together, both have the legal right to marry, have the intention to marry and also, present yourself to the community as a married couple.

The State of Colorado fully recognizes a common law marriage as having the same rights, responsibilities, privileges, and legal effect as a statutory marriage.

Determining whether a common law marriage exists requires a fact-intensive inquiry by the courts. Often, the courts will look at the following factors to determine the existence of a common-law marriage:

Length of time of the relationship

Use of the term husband/wife/partner/etc.

Presence / absence of joint tax returns, mutual estate planning documents, and statements / affidavits affirming the existence of a marriage

Testimony from witnesses regarding whether or **not** the couple has held themselves out as married

Ownership of joint property

In the case of <u>same-sex relationships</u>, the determination of whether a common - law marriage exists can be particularly complex.

While there is no appellate - level law in Colorado providing that same-sex couples can be engaged in a common-law marriage, several courts have applied the same factors and inquiry to determine whether a same-sex common-law marriage exists.

In her book <u>Outrageous Openness</u>, Tosha Silver writes about her straight-laced, highly-skeptical, economics professor friend Don, who liked to introduce Tosha as his "wacky, psychic pal with a degree from Yale."

One day, Tosha asked Don, "Really Don, in total truth. Has anything ever happened that made you wonder if you had the full picture? Anything ever rock your perfect little rational world?"

Don went on to tell her about one night when he was in college, when he went to sleep before his roommate had come home for the night. At 3 am, Don awoke with a pounding heart and heard his roommate calling out his name, twice. But the room was empty.

He stumbled out to his VW Bug, woke up with a start, put on his clothes, walked to his car, and started driving. But it felt more like the car was driving itself to the side of the road several blocks away. Like a magnet, Don was drawn to a spot ten blocks away, where he found his roommate buried under a snowbank, drunk, disoriented, and freezing.

Tosha was fascinated. "Man, you gotta be kidding me. This didn't change your life at all?"

"No way," said Don. "I had to see it all as a coincidence. If I hadn't, I would have had to question everything."

Don is **not** the only rationalist to sweep under the carpet an anomalous experience that **didn't** fit into his world view.

If he had allowed himself to realize that he had come face to the face with a perfect example of human telepathy and clairvoyance, he might have faced a threatening, that perhaps his worldview isn't large enough to encompass what really happens in people's lives.

Extraordinary Knowing

She contacted the president of the <u>American Society of Dowsers</u>, Harold McCoy in Fayetteville, Arkansas, and explained that a harp had been stolen from Oakland, California. She asked Harold if he could help her locate the harp.

Harold said, "Give me a second. I'll tell you if it's still in Oakland." He was silent for a moment and then said, "Well, it's still there. Send me a street map of Oakland and I'll locate that harp for you."

Lisby overnighted Harold a map of Oakland. Two - days later, he called to give her the address of where the harp was located.

Lisby had never heard of the street he named, but she passed the information along to the police. The police shook their heads. They couldn't issue a search warrant based on a hunch.

So Lisby decided to drive over and post flyers within a two block radius of the address Harold had given her, offering a reward for the return of the harp.

Three days later, her phone rang. A man said that his neighbor had recently showed him the exact harp the flyer was describing. He promised to give it to a teenage boy who would deliver it to her in the rear parking lot of an all-night Safeway.

In spite of her own skepticism, Lisby showed up at the appointed time and place, where a young man loaded the harp into the back of her station wagon. That's when Lisby came to the same conclusion Don would have come to if he had accepted what had happened with, he and his roommate. This changes everything.

Lisby went on to write a wonderful book <u>Extraordinary Knowing: Science, Skepticism</u>, and the <u>Inexplicable Powers of the Human Mind</u>, which is full of stories of people who knew things they shouldn't have, as well as the scientific data supporting the existence of paranormal phenomena like telepathy, clairvoyance, remote viewing, and the power of prayer.

The Neurosurgeon's Success Secret

Lisby was talking to a client, a neurosurgeon with impeccable credentials and an uncanny ability to perform the most dangerous surgeries. In spite of how life-threatening his surgeries were, his patients never seemed to die. But this neurosurgeon kept getting migraines, and standard treatment wasn't working, so he went to see Lisby.

She helped him pinpoint exactly when the headaches began. It turns out the headaches started right when he stopped teaching medical students and residents at the university hospital. Why did he stop teaching? He was reluctant to tell her, but he finally confessed.

The neurosurgeon admitted that his success rates are so high because he waits until a white light surrounds the patient's head. Then — and only then — he knows it's safe to operate. Her face immediately crumpled as she nodded her head and leaned into me. I'm not sure how long we stood there with our arms wrapped around one another.


Once her tears had subsided enough for her to speak, she told me it was the one year anniversary of her teen daughter's passing. — Jeannie Walsh

Reading HIS words in the Bible fills me with joy and peace. My goal now is to serve HIM, not to be president of my country. Many people from my group tried to kill me, but God has always saved me. I thank my Lord Jesus Christ for changing my life's concepts.

6 Stories of Angels, Prayers and Miracles

Some of the most fascinating and uplifting stories of the unexplained are those that people perceive as being <u>miraculous</u> in nature. Sometimes they are in the form of answered prayers or are seen as the actions of <u>guardian Angels</u>. These remarkable events and encounters lend comfort, <u>strengthen faith</u> -- even save lives -- at times when it seems these things are needed most.

Are they literally from <u>heaven</u>, or are they created by a little - understood interaction of our <u>consciousness</u> with a profoundly <u>mysterious universe</u>? However, you view them, these real-life experiences are worth our attention.

The Home Run

While many of these kinds of stories are life-altering, or otherwise deeply affect the people who experience them, some involve activities as seemingly inconsequential as a kids' baseball game.

Consider John D.'s story. His baseball team had made it to the playoffs but was struggling in one of the semi-final games. John's team was at bat in the bottom of the last inning with two outs, two strikes, and three balls, bases loaded. His team was behind, 7 to 5. Then something very unusual happened:

"Our second baseman called a timeout so he could tie his shoe," John says. "I was sitting on the bench when suddenly a strange man I had never seen before appeared in front of me. I was frozen still and my blood turned to ice. He was dressed all in black and he spoke without even looking at me. I was not very fond of our batter. This man said, 'Do you hold courage in this boy, and do you have faith?' At that, I turned to my coach, who had taken off his sunglasses and was sitting right next to me; he didn't even notice the man. I turned back to the stranger, but he was gone. The next moment, our second baseman called time in. The next pitch, our batter hit a home run out of the park, winning us the game 8 to 7. We went on to win the championship."

Angel's Guiding Hand

Winning a baseball game is one thing, but escaping serious injury is quite another. Jackie B. believes that her guardian Angel came to her aid on two such occasions. Most interesting, her testimony is that she actually physically felt and heard this protective force. Both happened when she was a child of kindergarten age:

"Everybody in the town used to go to the hill by the post office to sled in the winter," says Jackie. "I was sledding with my family and I went to the steep part. I closed my eyes and went down. I apparently hit someone going down and I was spinning out of control. I was heading for the metal guardrail. I didn't know what to do. I suddenly felt something push my chest down. I came within less than a half inch of the rail but didn't hit it. I could have lost my nose."

"The second experience was during a celebration of my birthday in school. I went to put down my crown on the bench at the playground during recess. I was running back to play with my friends. Three boys suddenly tripped me. This playground had a lot of metal things and wood chips (not a good combo). I went flying and hit something about 1/4 of an inch under my eye. But I felt something pull me back when I fell. The teachers said that they saw me sort of fly forward then fly back at the same time. As they hurried me to the nurse's office, I heard an unfamiliar voice keep telling me, 'Don't worry. I'm here. God doesn't want anything to happen to his baby.'"

The Accident Warning

Is our future planned, and is this therefore how psychics and <u>prophets</u> can see the future? Or is the future only a set of possibilities, the path to which can be altered by our actions? A reader with the username Hfen writes how she received two separate and remarkable warnings about a possible future incident toward which she was heading. They may have saved her life:

"At approximately four in the morning, my phone rang," writes Hfen. "It was my sister calling from across the country. Her voice trembled and she was near tears. She told me she had a vision of me being in a car accident.

She didn't say whether or not I was killed in it, but the sound of her voice made me think she did believe this but was afraid to tell me. She told me to pray and she said she would pray for me. She told me to be careful, to take another route to work -- anything I could do. I told her I believed her and would call our mother and ask her to pray with us.

I left for work at the hospital, terrified but strengthened in the spirit. I went to talk to patients about some concerns.

As I was leaving, a man sitting in a wheelchair near the door called to me. I went to him expecting that he had a complaint against the hospital. He told me God had given him a message that I would be in a car accident! He said someone not paying attention would hit me. I was so shocked I almost fainted. He said he would pray for me and that God loved me. I felt weak in the knees as I left the hospital. I drove like a little old lady as I observed every intersection, stop sign and stop light. When I got home, I called my mom and sister and told them I was fine."

The Flight Papers

A saved relationship can be just as important as a saved life. A reader calling herself Smigenk relates how a little "miracle" might have rescued her troubled marriage. A few years ago, she was making every effort to mend her rocky relationship with her husband and set up a long romantic weekend in Bermuda. Then things started to go wrong, and it seemed her plans were ruined... until "fate" intervened:

"My husband grudgingly agreed to go but was concerned with the short time between our connecting flights," Smigenk says. "We thought things were going well going into Philly, but there had been some bad weather and the planes were backed up; hence, we were put in a holding pattern and landed just as our connecting flight to Bermuda was due to board. We rushed through the airport, only to arrive at the check-in desk as the gate door was closing. I was devastated and my husband was not in a good mood.

We asked for new flights but were told that it would take two more flights and about 10 more hours to arrive. My husband said, 'That's it. I'm not putting up with this anymore,' and started to walk out of the area and -- I just knew - and out of the marriage. I was truly devastated. As my husband was walking away, the attendant saw on the counter (and I swear it had not been there when we checked in) a packet. She was obviously upset that it was still there. It turned out to be the landing papers packet that the pilot must have on board to land in a different country. She quickly called the plane to return.

The plane had been on the runway ready to start powering up the engines. It returned to the gate for the papers and they allowed us (and others) to get on.

Our time in Bermuda was wonderful and we resolved to work on our problems. Our marriage has gone through more rough times, but we both have never forgotten that incident in the airport when I felt as if my world had collapsed and was given a miracle that helped us keep a marriage and a family together."

The Reading Angel

It's remarkable how many stories of Angels come out of hospital experiences.

Maybe not so hard to understand when we realize they are places of sharply focused emotions, prayers, and hope. Reader DBayLorBaby entered the hospital in 1994 with acute pain from "a fibroid tumor the size of a grapefruit" in her uterus. The surgery was successful but more complicated than expected, and her troubles weren't over:

"I was in horrible pain," DBayLorBaby recalls. "The doctor gave me a morphine IV drip, only to find out that I am allergic to morphine. I had an allergic reaction, and so they counteracted with some other meds. I was horrified! I had just had a major surgery, learned that I might not be able to have children in the future and had just suffered an acute drug reaction. That same night they gave me another pain med and I slept soundly for a few hours.

I awoke in the middle of the night. According to the wall clock, it was 2:45. I heard someone speaking and realized someone was at my bedside. It was a young woman with short brown hair and wearing a white hospital staff uniform. She was sitting and reading aloud from the Bible. I said to her, 'Am I alright? Why are you here with me?'

She stopped reading but didn't turn to look at me. She simply said, 'I was sent here to make sure you'd be alright. You are going to be fine. Now you should get some rest and go back to sleep.' She began to read again and I drifted off back to sleep. The next day, I was having my checkup with my doctor and I explained to him what happened during the night before. He looked puzzled and checked my post-surgery reports and notes. He told me that no nurses or doctors were stationed to sit with me the night before. I questioned all of the nurses who cared for me; each said the same, that no nurses or doctors had visited my room that night for anything except to check my vitals. To this day, I believe that I was visited by my guardian Angel that night. She was sent to comfort me and assure me that I would be okay. Coincidentally, the time on the clock that night, 2:45 a.m., is the exact time recorded on my birth certificate that I was born!"

Rescued From Hopelessness

Perhaps more painful than any injury or illness is the feeling of utter hopelessness -- the despair of the soul that leads one to thoughts of suicide. Dean S. knew this pain as he was going through a divorce at the age of 26. The thought of being apart from his two daughters, aged three and one, was almost more than he could bear. But in one night of stormy darkness, Dean was given renewed hope:

"I was working on a drill rig as a derrickman and seriously thought of taking my life as I looked down the high 128-foot derrick I worked in," says Dean. "My family and I have strong beliefs in Jesus, but it was hard not to contemplate suicide. In the worst thunderstorm I'd ever seen, I climbed the derrick to take my position to pull pipe out of the hole we were drilling.

My co - workers said, 'You don't have to go up. We'd rather take some downtime than lose a man up there.' I brushed them off and climbed anyway. Lightning flashed all around me, thunder boomed. I cried to God to take me. If I couldn't have my family, I didn't want to live... but I couldn't take my own life in suicide. God spared me. I don't know how I survived that night, but I did.

A couple of weeks later, I bought a small Bible and traveled to the Peace River Hills, where my family has lived for so long. I sat down on top of one of the green hills and started to read. I had such a warm feeling enter into me as the sun parted through the clouds and shone on me. It was raining all around me, but I was dry and warm in my small spot on top of that hill.

I now have moved on to a better life, have met the girl of my dreams and the love of my life, and we have a wonderful family together along with my two daughters. Thank you, Lord Jesus and the Angels you sent that day to touch my soul!"

The Vision

My miracle happened many years ago when I was still in high school, I don't remember the exact date. I do remember that I had not been a legal driver for long and had very little experience driving. I was also a new Christian, having accepted Christ only about a year before. I think that I was 16 and a sophomore in high school. Anyway, what happened is that I lived in a housing project and one of my neighbors had 2 kids, a 2 year old and a 4 year old. The kids father worked away and was almost never home and the mom drank a lot and did not take very good care of her kids.

One morning I noticed the boys playing outside by themselves and the youngest one was playing with a **hot** wheel's car in the dirt underneath the rear of our car, I told him **not** to play there anymore and sent him to his own yard.

About 4 or 5 -hours later I decided to go to a friend's house and got into the car, started the engine and attempted to put the car in reverse. The gearshift slipped pass reverse and as I tried to pull it back to "R" it would go back into park. I tried several times and was getting really frustrated. No matter what I did the car would not go into reverse. Suddenly I had a vision, not just a thought, but an actual vision of the 2 - year - old play underneath the rear of my car.

I actually saw this just as it had been earlier that day. I thought to myself there is no way that he could still be there, and anyway I had seen him leave when I had told him to, still, I decided to check and sure enough, there he was. He had a small bicycle laying behind my rear tire on the passenger side of my car, and he was underneath the trunk area playing with a toy.

I can't know for sure what happened that day, but I sincerely believe that God saved two people by causing me to have that vision. Not only the life of the little boy, but my own as well.

I feel certain that I would **not** have been found at fault legally since I could **not** possibly have known he was there, but I would have been guilty in my own mind and heart and would **not** have been able to deal with it. The vision that I saw was **not** exactly the same as the actual circumstances, but it is my firm belief that it was from God.

God's Personal Prophecy

Here is a brief sketch of two verifiable revilements, coupled with specific arrangements of circumstances, that I could not dismiss. One began at my work, 1982, 2:20 PM. An unmistakable "voice"--"(an 11 year old boy in our small Church) will soon have an accident, but he won't die." Unable to call his mother, I testified at our 7 PM prayer service, not knowing a school chum had accidentally shot him in the cheek at 4 PM. His parents had told me of their impending divorce. Now, there was no divorce, and he is OK. He still carries the inoperable "22" slug, just touching his spinal cord.

Another similar one, before, on Jan. 3, 1979, near a girl at her cash register. The hard to identify, yet unmistakable "Voice" -- "some guy will attack her". Then, she briefly appeared to me as dead. I asked The Lord to help me in telling her of this. She did respond graciously. My attempt to borrow a tape recorder nearby failed. After a time, she described being hired "about a week from now" with her roommate, to watch a house for an hour for a security company officer, including the officer's name, etc. Next day, I unsuccessfully asked my pastor to help report to the police. I finally did it seven days later, just 26 hours before the "officer" killed both girls. From jail he named the very one who refused the tape recorder, saying "he and I planned a photo and prostitution business". The Ministry and others declared "you have ESP, and/or a gift from God". My reply is still "neither one! These are strictly spontaneous and only at The Lord's choosing". This must be in harmony with all of The Bible's prophetically inspired writings.

Such provable arrangements and revilements, through whosoever HE will, are also significantly HIS Word.

A Night I Will Never Forget

One night after a long day me and my daughter sat down in the living room to watch to like we normally do but that night I was a little uneasy from all the stress I was under. It was a Tuesday evening, and the restaurant was empty except for one other diner. My husband said he hoped that he would **not** have a crowd there later, spoiling our quiet evening.

I ordered dinner, as did my husband. I ordered Moreton Bay Bugs. I took an entire bug into my mouth, but it would not pass down my restricted Ossiphageous.

I started choking, standing, trying to speak, but then remember nothing. I was in such a beautiful place. The fields were green and manicured and I was just a child once again. To this day, I feel my father's presence, as when I am troubled, at times the room fills with the smell of someone smoking a cigarette. My father was never seen without one in his hand. I will ask the new owner of the family home if the old wooden couch which I slept on when a child is still in the home, as my mother and her sister had come and removed everything of value from the home. As I sat one day, during the time of my last visit, I reminisced about the times of when I would sleep on this hard sofa. I gently rubbed the ends of the two arms of this wooden couch. Suddenly, a spring caused the end to spring open, showing the silverware that my much adored Uncle had hidden. I closed the two spring pieces and told Uncle Nick his secret was safe with me.

I was just 20 - years - old and a struggling college student. I wanted out of the dorms, so I had just put down a deposit for my first apartment. I had only \$50 left to my name. I had a job and was living pay check by pay check. But. Life was good.

It was my last night in the dorms, before being kicked out for the summer. My roommate had already left for the summer. What was a gal to do in the dorms with no one around?

Amazed and perplexed I grabbed my key went to the bedroom door and sure enough it was locked. I even ran downstairs and check the building door and it too was locked.

This was a miracle that can only be explained by faith. All you need to do is A. S. K.

A Healing Miracle

On Sunday morning May 30, 2004 at three o'clock, the shrill ringing of the telephone awakened a grandmother from a deep sleep. The voice on the line asked. "Do you know a young man by the name of Eric Webb?" Cold chills over took the grandmother. She immediately sensed that something was very wrong. In a shaky voice she replied, "Yes, he is my grandson, has something happened?" He has been in a very bad accident and you need to go to the local hospital immediately." No more information was given...

She quickly began to dress while praying that her grandson would **not** be hurt too severely. Eric's grandfather had heard the phone conversation and was up and preparing to leave for the hospital as well. In a very short time, they were on their way.

Within less than a mile from their home, they saw the ambulance and police car lights flashing in the darkness. A policeman on the scene directed them to detour around the accident and provided them with some information. There was just Eric's vehicle involved and no one else was hurt. He also said their grandson was at the hospital and a helicopter had been called to air lift him to a larger hospital in Missouri due to the extent of his injuries.

Upon arriving at the local hospital, they were met by a nurse who escorted them to a small waiting room. She said, "The helicopter is here and the doctor is preparing him for transport, then he will be in to talk with you." The grandmother called some friends and they arrived at the hospital soon thereafter. They waited with the grandparents in silence but joined them in prayer that God would spare their grandson's life. They had lost his mother (their daughter) in 1997.

Within minutes, the door opened and the doctor entered. He introduced himself and with a handshake began telling them the sad and horrifying extent of Eric's critical injuries.

"We don't hold out much hope that he will live" was the statement that rang in the ears of the grandparents for several hours. The doctor continued with his explanation in a very concerned voice. Your grandson has multiple broken bones, his brain is bleeding, both lungs have collapsed, and his face is severely damaged. If by some miracle he survives he will need a complete reconstruction of his face. He is on his way to St. John's hospital in Springfield, Missouri. He said there is one slight ray of hope; he was fighting us when he was brought in. He is sedated now and on life support for the trip in the helicopter.

As this was a Sunday Morning, there would be many Prayers going upward for Eric.

The friends said they would call everyone to request Prayer at their respective Churches. They would also contact their Pastor and would have a special Prayer for him during the morning service.

The grandparents went home and quickly packed an overnight bag, called some out of state relatives to give them the bad news and asked for Prayer. Also, a prayer Request was sent on the internet to a worldwide Prayer group.

Then they were on their way to the hospital where Eric had been flown. By this time, the sun was rising in the Eastern Sky and a beautiful Lord's Day was beginning. As they traveled the seventy miles from Harrison, Arkansas the grandparents were in constant prayer and asked for strength to face the days ahead. They both knew that it would be a miracle for Eric to recover but they also knew that "All things are possible through Christ who gives us strength."

Upon arriving at the hospital, they went quickly to the Trauma Emergency Room and were told by the receptionist that Eric was in the Trauma ICU. Instructions were to go there and inquires could be made via the telephone beside the door of the ICU.

The grandmother picked up the phone and a nurse asked, "May I help you? "I am Eric Webb's grandmother and we have just arrived." She was very kind and with concern in her voice said, "We have just gotten him from the ER and I am in the process of cleaning him up a bit; just have a seat in the waiting room and I will talk with you shortly."

The grandparents continued in silent prayer until the nurse came in. She dropped down on her knees in front of them and confirmed what the local doctor had said earlier. When asked what the prognosis was at this time, she explained; "He is in serious condition but he should live and as to what extent of damage, we'll have to wait and see." She then asked if we wanted to see him for a few minutes. He was in an induced coma and continued to be on life support.

The grandmother was somewhat prepared as her sister was in a similar condition from brain surgery in December.

As they entered the ICU, Eric was motionless and of course all the tubes (One in each side draining fluid from his lungs, one in his head to drain blood from his brain and all the other tubes, wires, etc. required for the machines that were connected to him). His face was not disfigured as much as they were prepared for. He had a broken nose, stitches in his right eye lid and several small cuts and bruises on his face. Eric's grandfather was overcome and began to weep silently as the grandmother prayed over him asking for a healing miracle and for the flow of blood from his brain to stop. They were only allowed to stay for a very few minutes and was told the time of the next visiting hours.

There were tornado warnings in the area within an hour or so following the visit and all visitors were asked to take refuge in the basement of the hospital.

While there the friends that were with the grandparents in the early morning hours arrived and were asked to join them in the hospital basement. They were welcomed and supportive in giving a report of the abundance of prayers in all the local churches for Eric.

The storm passed by without spawning a tornado and all hospital visitors were allowed to return to the patient rooms or to the waiting room. Before the next visiting time (Every four hours) the Pastor and his wife were there and several of Eric's friends.

The grandparents gave up some of their time with Eric so that all who wanted could see him and say a prayer for him. There were many Prayers for healing said for him that day.

Hospitality rooms were provided for a minimal fee. Through the help of Eric's nurse, the grandparents made reservations for the coming nights as they wanted to be near their grandson.

After the last visit with Eric that night they retired to their room. They were still much in prayer but had a more positive feeling that their grandson would make it. They had a fairly good night and were up early the next morning. They had time to get something to eat before the first visiting time of the day.

The next two days were pretty much the same with little or no change in Eric. Lots of friends and relatives came to visit and Prayers were continually said on his behalf. The last visit on Tuesday night, Eric was awake and could answer some questions. He was coming out of the induced coma and his color was improving. The grandparents visited the length of the time allowed before going to the room for the night. At approximately 11:00 P M, the telephone rang. The grandmother answered and a male voice said I am from the ICU, there is "Nothing wrong." Eric doesn't remember you being in to see him tonight. He would like to see you now.

They wasted no time in getting dressed and down to ICU. The life support had been removed and he was breathing on his own. The nurse stated, "He is doing well and is responding. The tubes that I didn't remove, he did. The grandparents spent about thirty minutes with him and when he complained of pain, he was given medication to make him comfortable. When he was relaxed and going to sleep, they slipped out and went to the room for a peaceful and thankful night.

Eric continued to improve and was taken from ICU to a regular room on Wednesday. He still had the draining tubes in his lungs and the one in his head but the fluid was slowing down as well as the blood from his brain. In the meantime, a plastic surgeon was planning to set his broken nose as it was somewhat crushed and needed to be straightened. The cuts and bruises on his face were healing rapidly. There was a noticeable healing power taking place within Eric's broken body. He had broken ribs and both collar bones were broken with one shoulder dislocated.

Within the following two days all the tubes were removed and he was able to be sitting up in a chair. The surgery on his nose was completed without incident except he had a reaction to the anesthesia and was disoriented for most of the night following the surgery.

The next day he was able to be up in a wheel chair and be moving around in the hospital, even had a short stay outside in the sunshine.

Eric was well enough to come home exactly one week and a day from the date of his accident. The doctors were not sure just how long it would be until all the broken bones were healed but they seemed certain he would never have full use of his right arm due to the shoulder injury. The grandparents never lost faith and continued to pray for complete healing.

The follow-up visit to the doctors was remarkable with everything showing much improvement and healing better than expected. There was no time frame given as to when he would return to work, but within six weeks Eric had gone back to work. There are no noticeable scares on his face. No one would ever know his nose was broken.

The doctors may not admit a Miracle but the grandparents and Eric know better. His team of doctors was wonderful but divine intervention was the ingredient that "Made Eric whole again". Eric's family will always believe a Miracle is why he is alive today.

Eric is now a handsome young man with no ill effects from this terrible accident.

Miracle By the Fence

When I used to be much younger, I loved to be adventurous. Nature was sort of my thing. I think it happened when I was about six or seven probably around that age or so. I was outside, and I had my little face pressed against the fence as I watched the streets.

Then suddenly a voice came to my head. It spoke to me but it was my voice. My voice telling me, "stand back". There is a drunk crazy person coming your way." I wondered why I was telling myself this. So, I took a few steps back and a few seconds later a man with torn clothes walked by drunk, looking at me and laughing. My little self was creeped and confused and relieved all at the same time. I ran away but something in the back me my head told me that if that voice hadn't spoken to me, I would still have had my face pressed against the fence and who would have known what that man could have done to me. I am now fifteen and I look back at this as a miracle. God really does exist and takes care his children.

The Parking Lot

After returning to my car, I was putting my money away and preparing to pull out of the parking lot. A guy approached my car and knocked on my driver's side window. I turned my head to look behind me to see where he was pointing and when I turned my head back towards him there was a gun in my face. He ran off and I took the opportunity to run back in the building and alert the staff who of course called the police. Mind you, when I ran in the building, I left all of my money on the front seat of the car, car running, and car door open.

So anytime I question whether God loves me, or if HE's still with me, even when I'm selfish and disobedient, I think back to how HE spared my life and more importantly gave HIS for little ole me. Thank you, Jesus!

A Message In A Dream

I had been sick for what seemed like forever. For a week I couldn't keep anything down, food or liquid. I would make countless trips to the bathroom to be sick, but just didn't want to go to a doctor, thinking it was only the flu. Finally, one night, my husband said, "this is it, you're going to the hospital."

We arrived at the emergency room shortly after midnight. There were no other patients, so I was taken in quickly.

I explained to the doctors and nurses what had been happening in the past week, and they all agreed that I probably had the flu, and that I was seriously dehydrated. They admitted me to the hospital and began to run tests on me.

Being half way "out of it", I knew I had to drink a chalky solution, but also knew that it would not stay down. I agreed to let them put a tube down my nose, into my throat so that they could pump in the liquid. That was my entry into torture. As they maneuvered the tube up through my nose, I know that people in the street could hear me screaming. "Jesus! Help Me!" I screamed, with tears spilling down my face. One of the nurses told me to be calm, that it would be over in just a few minutes, but that did not help.

The nurses took blood from whatever vein they could reach. I was taken to X-ray, had an ultrasound done on my abdomen, and an MRI. The results were that my gall bladder, spleen, kidneys, were all swollen and inflamed. For an unknown reason, my organs were shutting down.

At about 5 am that morning, the doctor in charge of the Emergency room came to me, and I will never forget the look in his eyes as he took my hand and said, "Good luck". This man knew I was dying and didn't know how to express it!

I prayed. I talked to God and told him, that if I died that day in the hospital, it would be alright. I knew that Jesus was my Savior, I believed in HIM, and I would open my eyes in Heaven.

I spent two weeks in the hospital, unable to move from my bed, I had serious bouts of vomiting, and not wanting to soil the bed, often made a commotion reaching for the bedpan or small tub on the table beside the bed. I was unable to even move to the bath room, and the nurses were getting upset that I was not taking care of myself as I should. I did not begin to feel any better, with the constant flow of nurses in and out of the room to take blood, or at night to check to see if I was sleeping well. It sounds funny now, how can you sleep when someone turns on the overhead light to ask if you're sleeping?

One night I seemed to wake up, and I could barely see two white figures at the foot of my bed. They were talking, and one said to the other "she's not getting any better, she has had a seizure."

I felt myself falling back to sleep, and it seemed to me that I saw a book, opened, and on the page was the number 116. Just as I started to completely fall asleep, I noticed that the book had Golden edges around the pages.

The next morning a doctor came to tell me that I had contracted a strong case of food poisoning. I also had E coli in my system, but everything was clearing up and I would be able to go home the next day.

I couldn't get the dream of the book out of my mind, the golden pages had to be in the Bible. For some reason I kept feeling the message had to do with Psalms.

When I got home that afternoon, and settled in, I found my Bible and turned to Psalms 116. What I found there both amazed me and gave me great comfort. Proof that God listens, and that HE knew me and knew my trouble and delivered me.

Keep in mind in March 2010 she had a test that was done with Imaging. Sort ta of like an X ray.

It showed then that her aspiration was moderate.

Then in July when she had pneumonia the imaging showed 100%.

The imaging done last week showed NO aspiration! Nada, NONE!

It just confirmed what I already knew. She is doing well and I give God the praise every day for healing her.

Sorry my story was so long.... so much for making a long story short. LOL. I know it's a miracle every day when we wake up and can breathe, walk and talk. But this one was different for me. Amazing.!! She will be 92 February 9th.

So Many Miracles

When I was around 17 - God showed me that the boy I was engaged to was a homosexual and that he was in danger. He showed me exactly where he was - in a house of an older man. I was able to go there and talk to the man's mother and prevent any other young men from going there.

She listened, but after I FINISHED, She said I had reached the wrong number, but that she would help me. She got me into a brand new three bedroom apartment that very next day! I had my baby there - I was ill with toxemia, but I volunteered for her program which was the cheese and butter program. She paid my back light bill and over the years, she aided me in getting many people to help with light bills, shelter and other things. Her name was Doris Malick. Malick in Arabic means Angel!!!!!!!!

I was driving down the road to work. I had asked God to use me in ministry. I heard a voice say "star...". I did not know what that meant... on my way home from work - I decided to take another route. I came across a building called the 'the Star of Hope'... I went in and introduced myself and told them God had told me to teach Bible study there.

Something I had never done in my life! They looked at me like I was a not right in the head... and I was told that they could not use me... I left my name and address. A week later - I was called and invited to teach there. I did so for the next four years at both locations. I never missed a time in four years -2nd and 4th Fridays and 1st and 3rd Saturdays. I was so blessed. I did this with a little ministry I formed with some blessed ladies. The ministry name is "True Witness Ministries". I am now in Afghanistan and still teaching the word of God. Have many other incidents that add up far too many to tell.

I want to write a book and will do so soon. God has never let me down. HE always provides. HE is always there. HE has HIS Angels around you to encourage, protect and help you. HE did not let me die. He gave me a brand new start with my wonderful husband. He sent me to the far corners of the world to find my husband. So. Never give up.

Mason

Two summers ago, in midafternoon I had just got done with work and left for home. Every day like always I pulled into the driveway and walked up to the door to be greeted by my four years old son Mason. He is this brilliant little boy with these huge bright eyes who wears a superman suit underneath his clothes just like Clark Kent. Now when Mason was about two years old, we had a pregnancy go into early labor and baby Jacob only lived for a short time after being born. It was a very hard time for all of us and at the funeral with this tiny little casket, which was very confusing for Mason, the saddest thing I have ever seen was Mason walk up to the casket and tell his little brother Jacob, who he had only known as the baby boy in mommy's belly, "bye baby Jacob, we love you". Instantly my wife, me and several around us who could hear what he said, broke down into tears at the sound of a tiny little boy telling his brother that he loved him and goodbye forever.

I came inside the screen door and was covered with a hug before I could even say "hi buddy". Today was a little different because during the summer we would go for a walk almost every day when I would get home but today, we needed to run some errands. I told him he could come with so like always he raced to get his shoes on and went for the door to go outside and jump up in the truck. Before I could leave, I needed to find Ashlee and new baby girl Reagan to let them know we were leaving and to sneak a kiss from my ladies.

Since I just got home, she had a few questions for me but I was a little anxious because I knew Mason had already gone outside to get into the truck, which was no big deal because he would never even go near the road. Plus, this was a normal routine for him to go get himself buckled in by himself. Getting ready to walk out I kept getting caught in conversation with Ashlee, but something felt heavy in the air. I don't know how to describe it but that's just the way it felt. Then a very strange low pitched noise in the back ground of the conversation was what I had heard. It almost sounded like a baby calf gasping for it's first few breaths after being born.

I grew up on a farm so I knew the sound pretty well but I just figured it was a creaking door or a cat from outside, which we had tons of in our neighborhood. A few seconds later I heard it again and just felt this panic and raced towards the door. Swinging the door open I sprinted towards the truck not knowing if anything was even wrong. What I saw I will never forget.

I had a full size truck with leather electric seats that were controlled by two little buttons on the door. His seat was behind the driver's seat and there was no rear door on that side so he would squeeze between the seat and the frame of the truck. When I would get out of my truck it was habit for me to hit the forward button so that when we would leave for somewhere it was no problem for him to squeeze in.

When Mason went outside and opened the door to the truck he crawled in just like any other time.

But this time while he was squeezing in, he hit the button to move the seat back to driving position. Being that he is a little boy wasn't sure how to fix it so he tried to squeeze in before the seat got all the way back.

When I first got to the truck, I saw this tiny little boy who normally has this big bright smile on his face turning blue from being pinned between the seat and the frame at his neck and upper chest. Mind you that he has only been out there for two minutes but I thought for sure the worst. I instantly hit the button to release him and while it was moving, I continued to push the seat forward to speed up the process. When the seat moved far enough forward his limp little body just fell into my arms. Blood vessels were burst all over his face, neck and chest. It took about ten seconds for him to come back to me but before he did, I could feel this absolute whirlwind of emotions swirling in my body. Not knowing if I would have my son at the end of the day was unbearable.

When he came to, I remember feeling this mountain of sadness just dissipate but that wasn't the end. After I carried him over to the back door and sat down on the back step with him in my arms just crying like a baby. I yelled for Ashlee and continued to ask him a hundred questions. He answered them all just fine but I still had all these what if's going through my head. Could this cause a blood clot or an aneurism or anything else under the sun from being crushed with no air. We decided to take him to the emergency room just in case, where they gave him a clean bill of health.

You might think that would be the end of this, but it wasn't until I got home that I discovered some unusual things. We were home and Mason was tucked into our bed with Ashlee close by, I went out to the truck where the door had still been left open from our earlier ordeal. I wanted to know what he felt so out of curiosity I climbed into the back seat and used a stick to hit the button so the seat would move backward just like it did with Mason. I am not a small guy and I think I'm pretty strong but I put my shoulder into that seat and with every bit of my strength tried to stop that seat from moving but it was like I wasn't even there. After the seat had finished it's travel back wards, I realized it was much further than it was when Mason was pinned. So, for some reason it had only gone half as far as it should have and there is no way that a four year old boy stopped that seat.

Also, from his position it was impossible for him to come even close to being able to reach out and hit the button. Plus, he told me that he didn't hit the button to stop it.

After the realization that for some reason the seat stopped moving on it's own, I was already a little speechless, but until I put myself into the crushed position for myself, I tried my hardest to let out any kind of a sound but my lungs just wouldn't let me. I still wonder how he did it.

Me and Mason have talked about it plenty of times and he doesn't remember too much except that he was really scared but I can't help but wonder if his baby brother whom he refers to as an Angel, had anything to do with it.

God's Miracles

When I was a young divorced mother of 2, I needed \$10.00 to pay for a picture of my Church choir that I had ordered. Ten dollars may not seem like much but when you don't have any money, it may as well have been \$100. I had been promising the lady over & over again that I would have the money for the picture and apologizing each time I didn't.

She was so gracious about it but I was embarrassed that I never had such a small amount. One Sunday morning, before morning worship, I told her I would give her the \$10 that evening when I came. I knew I didn't have the money, didn't know where I would get it but enough was enough. I decided to trust God for it. During morning worship, my thoughts kept being interrupted with the fact that I promised her this money yet didn't have any way to get it - twice this happened. Each time I pushed it out of my mind and determined to praise God anyhow, this was HIS day. The thought of borrowing it came to me but I had "borrowed everyone out" and didn't want to continue to do that. After morning worship was over, I had just walked out of my pew when a member walked up to me and said, "The Lord told me to give you this!" The amazing thing was that I hadn't said a word to ANYONE about needing the money... it had to be God! Besides, I barely knew this lady as I had gotten saved just 2 months before. Second miracle happened in Phila, PA, Dec 29, 2009 while on my way to pick my sister up from the cancer hospital. It was about 8:45 am on Roosevelt Blvd & there was rush hour traffic. I was in the center lane of a 3 lane highway on my side. I needed to get into the right lane. I glanced over my right shoulder as I moved into the lane. I didn't see the white car alongside me in my blind side. I swerved back into my lane to avoid getting hit and almost hit the car in the lane on my left. So, I swerved back and began fishtailing back and forth in the center lane. I could hear my purse, cell phone and other papers hitting the floor and falling around. In a flash all I could think of was I'm gonna be hit & killed! My sister is gonna wonder where I am & my family will be devastated. I have a small convertible and there was traffic on both sides and behind me, all going at about 45 - 50 mph on this highway.

When I finally stopped, I was sitting across the center lane, facing a cement median about 3 feet high and the cars miraculously stopped in the middle and left lanes!! No one hit me, I didn't hit anyone or the cement median!

God had spared my life! Glory be to God! I turned my car to the way I was originally headed & picked my sister up. There was no damage to my car, I thought I would at least need a front end alignment. There are no words to express my gratitude, the only way I can show HIM is to dedicate my life to HIM and live my life for HIM.

God's Protection

I was born in Malta 1947 to a Maltese mother and father an English soldier, had met and married there and I was born 9 months later with septicemia, with no cure, I was left in a military hospital to die, was baptized and received the last rites. Mum asked for Our Lady's intercession that if I lived, I would be named after her. Mum was quite wealthy being head cook in the dock yard.

She had to take me away from the hospital, she then payed for a specialist to come from England who said all he could try was penicillin which was only used for amputees but I was dying so nothing to lose, had 15 boils on my body and weighed only 5 lbs., he lanced them and I was put in a bath of salt. I was the first baby to actually have penicillin.

Slowly my temperature was going down, I could only have goats' milk as I was so weak. I am now 64 years old named Miriam (Arabic for Mary). I know it was The Lord who did the miracle, but it was the Blessed Mother who prayed for me. Many things have happened in my life where I needed a miracle and the Lord has never let me down, when I go to Mass, I love to receive communion which is my spiritual medicine. I also have a strong bond with Our Lady and have dedicated my children and granddaughters to Her for Her protection, I am proud of them as they are good caring people. I also feel She is the one who took me to Her Son, Now I have a great love for Our Precious Lord, which I can't explain, but my life has a meaning now and without HIM in my life, I feel I, well my life would be "empty". Amen.

Three Miracles

When I was living in Hawaii studying as a pre-med major to become a doctor, God called me to attend a private Bible College in California. I pray for confirmation which is to receive a financial aid package that day and it came. So, I started to tell everyone that even though I have no money to pay for tuition, if it is God's will, he will rain money down into my room. So, I applied to the Bible College and was accepted as a music major.

Little do I know that the momentum of my throwing the rope and the steepness of the roof gathered up enough strength to pull me along with it. I was so scared at that time because I have no way of stopping the momentum and it was going fast. Suddenly, I felt someone pushed me back to the chimney and I was secured there until my partner can get to the rope. I was held tight onto the chimney by God's hand or an Angel of the Lord until the rope stop pulling. Praise God that I'm still alive today.

Third miracle – Again, I was preparing to inspect a steep roof with my partner. I climbed up the ladder first and since it had been raining a while ago, the roof was very slippery. I got to the top of the ladder and had one foot on the roof and was giving my other foot a push to gain momentum so I can walk up the steep roof. But the foot slipped and I started to slide. The next thing I knew I was back safely on the ladder like I never left. My partner down below watching the whole thing in horror asked me "how did you do that? How did you get back on the ladder like that?" He could not believe it.

But I knew it was the Angel of the Lord putting me back on the ladder so I will not fall off the steep roof. Praise the Lord again for his protection.

So, I called a friend and asked if she would drive me to the dealership. She said yes. About an hour later he called back and said that her parents were getting rid of a car and they said I could have it for free. What a blessing but there is more to the story.

When my friend came to the house she asked where my truck was and I said it should be in the driveway. My truck has been reposed the night before and I was never without a car. God is good all the time

No More Pain

In 1997 I was at work and all of sudden I could not walk for more than a few feet without being in severe pain. I went to the doctor and found I had a bad disc. He said he didn't want to do anything drastic at that time and a friend gave me a wheelchair to use. About a month later the doctor said he wanted to give me a lumbar injection. I was not looking forward to it. It was supposed to done on Wednesday and on Sunday I was prayed for by my friend at the prayer rail at church. The next day I had no pain have not had any serious back or leg pain in over 13 years. God is the God of miracles.

I looked to left and it was my brother, the trailer moved just enough for me to get out.

I turned back and he was gone, my brother had died 5 years ago. I haven't told anybody because they might think I'm mad or nuts, there is no way I moved that trailer. I couldn't. I was dying. I couldn't even breath. I no want.

I saw and I had no help, he helped me. I'm not religious in any way shape or form but this has changed my way of thinking and the only thing I can say is thanks, Jim, I love and miss you bro.

My First Miracle

The year was 1996 and I was 9. I took a 10 speed bicycle (I am still not sure who's bike it was) for a ride. I took it around the neighborhood, up and down the block and pedaling as fast as I could, when I see an access alley that ends into a main street with crossing traffic, thinking it was a long straight away, I would be able to go as fast as I can, and before I run into the street I would just make a quick left onto the side walk, or so I thought. His mouth was open, with bits of white saliva coming out. He was sooo skinny and looked like he was going to die.

It felt like, a heavy burden had just been lifted off their shoulders.

They left that morning and walked back home...

Now, in his late 40s, uncle Tu is the Director For Music in their Congregation Pentecostal Church in Samoa, America Samoa, USA, New Zealand and Australia. 


