MSTP > 18 What Did They Say "B"

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You have an opportunity to put in what they may talk about, yes, to add to their talk.

This is a story part of 25 Army, Navy, Marine, Air Force people, who are hidden out in the jungle for 36 hours, dressed in camouflage in two – people teams, and are just sitting there.

The majority of American soldiers have never witnessed large - scale battles or have been in some real hot and bad fire fights and have suffered through the terror of a Vietnam jungle ambush during their one - year tours. But when they did, dozens of men could die within minutes. For one, an acting squad leader within Delta Company, the ambush of October came just three - months after he arrived in Vietnam, and what mattered on that terrible day was whether you were in the shade or in the sunlight. Crouching for cover behind a three - foot high and two - foot wide anthill, he stayed out of the light and watched more sun light exposed his comrades to get shot by VC. He later crawled across the battlefield, "trying to find somebody that was still alive." But the bodies had been so shot up that many were unrecognizable. He did identifie one victim only by his 101^{st} Airborne tattoo.

Five special team people are standing in front of 215 bad drug cartel S.A. army men who have just surrendered. They have been bound with their hands and legs awaiting UH-1s coming in to get them.

The South American new Special Forces Army Col. back at Catia La Mar is radio called to come in and pick up 215 bad drug cartel army men. None were killed. Got back he would see them in less than an hour, departing in 5 - minutes. The men are soon all moved over in the shade for the next two - hours or so wait. Four of the 9 "T" team women go out up with Rita, in the front of the men facing south in the shade. More down a bit.

Why? Well, the next "T" unit mission was for two 10 – man (people) teams and a five people control command spot team to make up the mission team of 26 people teams. The six in the command control team part is: USAF Chief James, over all commander, USAF Chief Scott, second in command, Army Chief Carl, in charge of the two – site guard teams, Team radio is the USAF Special Forces Mission "T" unit commander Army Lt. Col. Raymond Fitzgerald. Also with them are Navy PO2. Rita Jo Dove (Linguist – for Spanish) and Army Cpl. Lisa Lynn Jackson (Linguist – for French). Teams go on this South America jungle mission.

SP (Sniper Protection) # 1: Marine Cpl. Booker Parks with SP Spotter Cpl. Ray Blackwood. Who are also in charge of # 1 - 4 teams of 2 people each.

Team # 1 A (1) 82nd > Army SSgt. Dora Miller (female) and Team # 1 B (2) Army Pvt2. Bert Thomas (male).

Team # 1 C (3) 82nd > Army SSgt. Sarah Durbin (female) and Team # 1 D (4) Army Sgt. Parker Rhodes (male).

Team # 1 E (5) Marine SSgt. Roland Jenkins (male) and Team # 1 F (6) Army Pfc. Angela (Sandy) Holliday (female).

Team # 1 G (7) Air Force SSgt. Paula McGill (female) and Team # 1 H (8) Army Pvt2. Henry Norman (male).

SP (Sniper Protection) # 2: Marine Cpl. John Coleman (male) with SP Spotter Cpl. Rick Malone (male). Who are also in charge of # 2 - 4 teams of 2 - people each.

Team # 2 A (1) 82nd > Army SSgt. Steve Clement (male) and Team # 2 B (2) USAF A1C Jessie Rodgers (female).

Team # 2 C (3) 82nd > Army SSgt. Fred Buckley (male) and Team # 2 D (4) Army Pfc. Lori Gross (female)

Team # 2 E (5) Army SSgt. Jerome Dickey (male) and Team # 2 F (6) Army Pvt. Rain Gifford (female).

Team # 2 G (7) AF SSgt. Donald Mueller (male) and Team # 2 H (8) Army Pvt2. Robert Muller (male).

With the two - teams fully maned they go out and train as a moving patrol unit team in two - different "T" unit jungle training two - wheel track areas. They practice stopping and getting down and off the trail, with each two - people moving off the trail on each side and train scattering a ways off each side of the trail and to hide. The five two - man teams taking turns up at point and many other patrol task over three - days of training.

Practice is making sure a meal stop location is clear, doing two - man camouflage holding spots and train to clear an area for the team for a small river crossing and many other potential real mission task training. These two - teams do not know just what this next mission will really be. They all do the fire at targets course four - times a day for two - days. The two - people on each of the 10 - teams are learning each other to work as a real team.

They all eat and still cover firing zones as a two – man (which, yes, some are women) team, sleep and do potty breaks as a team. Talk over for each one any mission personal weaknesses, mission strengths, mission fears and the real fact as that they each may have to shoot to kill. Talk over that this team is women heavy as it has 9 - women and 17 - men for a team of 26 people. Their Mission is to go down to City of Caracas, Venezuela and the field mission is out from there to the smaller village of Catia La Mar, Venezuela and on to the mission target which is 50 - miles more out in the jungle from there.

This team gets in from a Lear Jet and with 13 - men on one HU-1 chopper and 12 men on the second UH-1 chopper to fly out and to and over Catia La Mar.

Then they fly on for 50 - more miles to the team's LZ (Landing Zone). The two - UH-1s get into their LZ and the team hits the ground. They scatter a bit and cover their faces as the two - UH-1s leave. They have 6 - miles to move off as a patrol to hike to the team's first mission site, which is to stop a drug cartel army team of unknown size from hitting and killing off another drug cartel's two - loaded burros with four 40 - pound drug packs. They don't know if the or any attacking drug army men number, as they may be 50 or 100 or 400 bad drug cartel army Venezuela men. They are going to get there and will have to scope out the attacking drug army men to really know.

The team moves along this cart wheel two - track jungle path while staying alert and really looking and checking for the bad army men as this team is in a day early. Each of the two - man team is in the track spaced out good to the next two - men in the other track.

They see a lot of ripe eatable jungle fruit along this cart two - track jungle path. They have one team in the lead spot, the mission control men are in the middle, and the second team following, covering the team's rear. After they move for three - hours the lead team hand signs back as each team move off to their side and back away from the path and take good cover. "Click. Snack time take 20 - minutes," comes over each's radio ear phones (which are small like hearing aids). They move off into cover and takeoff back packs, remove a good size snack protein bar and water canteen and lean back on their packs as they also still stay alert. They softly talk about this mission part between team mates. The team has about a mile as yet to move on to the first mission site.

"Click. Drug cartel's two - loaded burros with four - men coming through. Insure you are hidden well from view of the cart path," each one's radio says. The team is hidden as they have been trained behind the jungle clumps of brush off each side of the path.

They move on through **not** knowing that 26 - men (people, both men and women) are just a ways off each side the cart path. The team rear men team radios out, it is time to move to the target.

The team is up and moving as they all stay on alert more because they are getting closer to their target mission site.

At the end of the next hour, they are all in their mission site places (spots) a little above the drug overnight shack and getting each their team's camouflage work done. The team control place or spot can view over the drug shack and lower land area where the drug cartel's two - loaded burros with four - men are coming up to the shack to stay for the night.

In the morning the sun is out with a few clouds drifting by with a nice breeze. They hope it stays that way all day. All is tight, hide and staying on alert, making their 100,000 firing zone checks. The drug cartel's two - loaded burros with four - men that is coming into the shack should be here about two - hours before dark. At the well - hidden control place the long radio gets a call over the head set. Six UH-1s and the South American new Special Army Forces Col. with a few of his men are at Catia La Mar standing by. The team is told by radio ear phones but they all know it is a 45 - minute UH-1 flight time to get here if this team needs any help. This team may have an hour of a lot of fire from some real bad drug cartel army men fighting time before any help gets here, help like those M-60s on the side of those UH-1 choppers.

At 2:10 p.m. all team radios. "Click. A lot of drug cartel army men are approaching this target coming in from the south / east." The whole team is looking to check just what is coming in for them. It looks like four - groups spaced apart by 15 - yards of 50 - men per group in four groups with a smaller group of 15 - men in the lead. The team just sits and watches them move in closer. "Click. "I am sure they will form up on two - sides of the path in small group of men with a good space between them." They have four - 50 - man teams. "Two - M-79 from each team. One close and one long shot to the far side over both side of the men's groups on both sides. Click plus count of two."

They watch the 215 - men move in closer. The small group of 15 - men stop out 20 - yards south from the shack as the cart path comes in from the south up to the shack. Not long and the second group of 100 men are in place on the west side of the cart path.

They are stopped but are talking and just milling around waiting to get their group of 50 - men in place to move to where they will ambush us coming in. "Click. Ready M-79s. Next click counts two."

By only their team they each have the two - M-79 men ready with who fires close and who fires far just past the far men and on which side. "Click." Two - seconds later the team hears four M-79s fire but it sounded like maybe only one loud fire of M-79s. Rita is right on the speaker, speaking in Spanish. "Only one M-79 grenade will kill 40 - of you men and really hurt a lot of others in the group of 50 men. Face north and pass out all weapons, put them out on the ground, then face south and sit down or be killed. Sit and don't move. We have with us six M-79 grenade launchers. All dead men will lose their men's balls by me personally." They all know she is a woman and the men know she means that. The men are not sure what to do and just are standing there. One of the men in the small group is at the group's outer edge, he puts his hand on top of his side hand gun. All hear the sound of his hand gun handle and his hand that is hit by the fired sniper shot, ah, oh, and also his loud scream from him out in pain. "Move the weapons out now or I count to four."

The weapons, hand guns, rifles, and knifes come flying out by being thrown out over the men to their north side. The men are turning around and sitting down facing south. The one main cartel drug army leader is really pissed - off by this but he also throws out his hand gun.

"I am sorry you need to sit in the hot sun. Time soon we will move you all to cool shade." Five from each team go out and start to bind men's hands and move the men over to shade and plastic strap the men's feet, with them facing south. Each goes back and gets and binds another one. Save the 15 leaders still in the hot sun for last to bind and move.

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(This is how the five - women are dressed. Not what you had in mind?)

Rita with the speaker in her hand tells the men in Spanish, she tell that, "They have been lied to, it is satan the devil's lie. I have died and I did not come back as a butterfly or any dog or any man. You will not get any one or three nor 72 virgin women after you die and go up to Allah's heaven. No matter where you go when you go back to the city, you go to jail or to go free, get someone with a Christian Bible and learn how to give your life over to Jesus. Two team people are doing first aid to the man's hand. Rita tells the men; you men were out here to kill other men. But the great Jesus sent us to save you from that killing. You would have been killed. The only thing you men have done is to be out here and you caused a small situation. You will be taken back and held for five - days or less or maybe a few more days. You will be asked questions, for yourself, a lot of questions.

"Then you will be asked some more questions from the South American New Special Forces Army Col. and his men. Then you all will be free to go. That is if you have not committed any big crimes the Police want you for. We could have killed you all but our God's Son, Jesus told us not to kill you.

"Our great Jesus asked us to save all of you. You all have an hour and 30 - minutes to think about all I have told you. The Bible is true, and it is very simple, it is the Bible way, is good, not the Bible way is bad, you each pick one way. It is easy to understand, a good way or a bad way, you each have to pick only one way. I'm done telling."

The five - women move a bit closer to the men. They stand there and visit some softly and just look over the men. Someone asked, "You sure we will go free?" (In Spanish) She nods back yes. About 35 - more minutes they hear the UH-1 choppers coming in. They land and the Col. comes over. On the speaker the Col. tells them they will be taken back to the city and held for three - up to 10 days.

And then be set free if they, yes, if you have not committed any big crimes the Police want you for. This will take a few hours to move all you men. Some may have to stay here over tonight. If so, we will bring back food for who is staying here over night. Who get to stay do not cause any problems with those people here. They, those people here really care about all you men because they could have killed you all and just left you here dead and then after you died, in a bit you would be without your balls of course.

They could see a lot of these men are thinking about what Rita said and what then the S. A. Army Col. said, a lot.

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Ah, but before this 215 - drug cartel bad army men got to their mission area, they wait.

Remember: Next "T" unit mission is for two - 10 - man (people) teams and a six - people control command team to make the mission team of 26 people. The team mostly are in teams of two - people in a hiding place and are in camouflage spots out in the remote jungle.

They are staying and are hiding in their two - people hiding spots for about 46 - hours. With nothing to do but look out at their firing zone and time also to think. Most of the team people also do really pray. They may talk in a not very loud but with only a soft voice. Here are what some of them of them talk about, as follows:

On team # 1 A (1) is $82^{nd} >$ Army SSgt. Dora Miller and Team # 1 B (2) Army Pvt2. Bert Thomas, "You are an Army SP and a jump instructor. That is a lot of training. What got you to want to join the "T" unit full time?" Bert asked her.

"That is a long story but I guess we have some time. I was stationed for a year, not in Vietnam because I am a woman and I am an Army SP shooter, so I was placed in Klaeng, Thailand for a year. Well, you may want to know also why I became a sniper. My father was in the Navy CBs (Navy Construction Builder Engineers) as a sniper to protect those men as they done their CB duty jobs. Him being away from mom and us kids so much in the Navy so I picked the Army. Folks back in the US didn't know but we had a lot of VCs cross over into Thailand to move VC army supplies south to the coast to be placed on small boats and moved east and back up into Vietnam. As a SP we fly with Army troops on UH-1s all over the south east Thailand out of our base at Klaeng. Thailand was not in the Vietnam war zone so women could be there. I was in a lot of hot war action there but not in any way as much as our three - Chiefs, Jay and Jay C. SP teams were in. A few times we were way out numbered with VC, we called out for help and more Army men jumped in around or in with us. The second time we called for help the Army jumped in 280 Army men, some landed right in with us. About 60 of those men landed right in with us and maybe 30 men didn't land right and hurt their ankles and feet and were almost useless to us. Part of us had to go do first aid on them, they couldn't even walk and took us away from the VC fire fight. The other side of our team was doing the fire fight and after I talked with many of them. I worked out they needed some more or some different kind training for being in combat jumping.

"When I returned to the US. I put in for jump school, got more training and then become also a jump instructor to get some small things changed so our men could land without getting hurt, then from that I moved up to buddy jumping. I got hooked up with your "T" people on that drug mission by buddy jumping with your SP spotter. Being with Jay A. and Jay C. praying for those two - Mexicans when Jay A. was in that shack with them and then praying for the healing of his. That is Steve's broken leg from landing on a big rock jumping in, well those two – really had a real true relationship with Jesus, which I then wanted and I knew I needed a lot more of. Anything else from me?" Asked Dora.

"Yeah. On your love life."

"Yeah. Well, I was age 15, I had an older sister, she is dating a lot and she always came home bitching to me, we shared a room together at home, bitching about every second or so date, you have a nice first date and next date only what they all want was in my paints. They don't want a life time commitment with me, I tell them I want me for my husband after high school or in college. No, they want in my paints now. I don't think she was more than 17 maybe, and she swore off boys, young men or any men until she is age 25.

"She didn't make it to age 25, she got married at age 21. I had a lot of dates and I found out the same thing, I am saving me for my husband but the good men are very hard to find.

"That is about it."

She is glancing at him but more so is looking out to their firing zone. "Ah, yeah, ah, me. Well, I am dating girls in high school and in the gym locker room other boys are naming out our high school girls as they are, as they said, are getting way past first base with. The girls at the time I was dating are named by those other guys, they say they have had them, I thought about them also and I then really lost a lot of respect for the girls in my high school. Well, all but two or three girls that were so called wall flowers. My uncle always said for me to get an ugly woman and you will never worry any. Later I worked out what he really meant. I didn't have the money to go to college and I still don't know what degree I would go to college for. So, I joined the Army. Yeah, I want a good woman, well really a good wife but where do I find one. Yeah, there are some great women here in the "T" unit but they are off limits with me being in the "T" unit and I am not ready to leave this "T" unit. I am getting older and just maybe I can find a good woman with a couple kids and maybe one who has lost her husband," Bert said.

"What do you mean by she lost her husband, like he got sick and he died or by a divorce?"

"That is what I love about all the "T" unit people. You guys get right down to the real deep heart of any questions. I mean as he got killed or died. It takes two - people falling out of love to have a divorce." He looks over at Dora until she glances over at him so he can read her face. Her glance and look is as she would really like to know. "I have given that a lot of thought. I think a woman with a girl and a younger boy, not any twins or not a boy and then a girl. I have talked alone with all you women and well, all but two of you women, alln want a girl and then a boy. I think it comes down to a mother and daughter to be bonding first. I picked up it would be better for me then to bond with the second kid as a boy. I would want her to have a good relationship with our lord and with our Jesus too," Bert said.

"So that why you go over to the main base worship Church service to meet maybe your potential lifelong mate. I have been the Army a few more years than you and I have seen Army widows and they mostly move off, back to their home town when they lose their husbands. You have any idea about that?"

"No." Bert says back. They don't visit any more for a long time.

(Team man # 1 A is: # 1) Dora - woman (What do you think they talk more about?)

(Team man # 1 B is: # 2) Bert - man (What do you think they talk more about?)

On team # 1 C (3) 82nd > Army SSgt. Sarah Durbin (female) and Team # 1 D (4) Army Sgt. Parker Rhodes (male). "Okay Parker, things are quit. Share with me you past love life and why did you go into the Army?" Sarah asked.

"Oh. I did Okay in school but was not an "A" student and for sure not any "D" and "F" student. But I really didn't apply myself much. Most of my mind was on girls and sports. In high school I dated and I had some girls, well very young women. In my school it was call a fling ding, both for the girls and boys. You dated 2 or 3 times and if that kind of worked us boys would ding the girl and for the girls is about the same, they would get dinged. Would stay on together still dinging but did look at others and then we move on. I don't think anyone got to upset over any break up much but maybe a few. Younger I heard about marring a virgin but that went away my last two - years in high school. Had no money to go on to any collage and no real money jobs there where I lived, so I with four others, we hooked up with the Army, maybe later I will use the GI Bill. Not much to tell. How about you?"

"I started dating when I was 16. You dated 2 or 3 times and most of what they wanted was in between my legs, as you know. My older sister was dating a young Army recruiter her last year in high school. They dated a lot it went on for a year after I got in the Army. I didn't see any way for me but the hard way for any collage and me working two - to four - jobs. My dad had an okay job but he thought a woman going to any collage was a waste of money unless she wanted to be a school teacher or maybe a nurse. Anything else from him was a no. I didn't have any interest in becoming a teacher or a nurse. My sister's now man friend had me come down and take the Army test.

"They said, I was well organized and I could go through basic and if I made it through Army basic I could go to Army supply school for a supply MOS whatever that was. I thought that over real hard for two - weeks. We had six - men and two - young women go in right after high school as they go into the Army and they came back and talked with us. They had went through Army basic and AIT whatever that was and told us where they were all now going. One girl now in Army supply and one guy were both going over to an Army Post in Germany. The rest to a state side Army Post, off in other US States. Talking with them I guess I was wowed some. I had no idea where I was going. Those two are planning on getting married over in Germany, that was another wow, for me. I did the H. S. grad walk and then two - weeks later went off to Army basic.

"After basic they moved us in a holding barracks area with the men but in a different close by barracks waiting for two - days for my supply AIT school date and they came an asked for any level headed people to go to the toughest AIT there is, to go SP school. Only three men's hands went up and I feel my hand go up. Okay you four - step, over here by me. I am thinking that just maybe I should not have done this.

He said, Okay tell you guys this, anyone finishing this SP hard school gets 30 - extra leave days where you have the rest of your time in the Army to use and at the end with a jump up in one rank. He said he needed 11 people. Then 8 - more men and four - more women stepped over.

He had now had 15 people. Someone asked him, "What is a SP?" He said a very special person is an Army sniper. Someone said, "A sniper kills people." All of you are in the Army now you are out of basic and you all are trained to kill people that are our US enemy. The AIT course is 8 - weeks long and at 4 - weeks you will get to pick an Army man or an Army woman as your team sniper spotter, which is a very important helper to any sniper.

"Also, if you come out in the top ten snipers you get first - pick of all those Army post you could go to. Yes, okay, I thought I will take Germany and will be at their wedding.

"I went to this AIT SP school. The first 4 - weeks as they were ten - times harder than in Army basic. My body went through hard combat things I did I didn't even know my body could do. My E and E skills were in the top - three. My rifle firing hits were the best in that whole class of 36 people. I had never fired a rifle before I went to basic. At 4 weeks we are down to only 19 people of the 36. They told us that only the top 8 people would make it to the end, that the real hard stuff was over. Only the 8 - best at E and E skills and rifle firing skills will make it. Oh, at first, he told us that this school would not count against us if we failed out. That we only would be in a later AIT class as we came in the Army for if we didn't make it. We got to pick our spotters from the 17 people who just washed out. I went through 3 - people before I got my man partner. I came out at number 2 from two - women and the 6 - men left. I went and checked at Army Admen and it would 6 - months maybe more before any more SP would be sent to Germany. They offered two slots at AIT SP school. The # 1 man and I # 2 took those two - slots. A year later they are looking for SP to jump. I volunteered. After I, well we get put over with the 82 > Air Born as a SP team and we both got another jump in rank. Then I went on and I got buddy jump qualified.

"As for my love life, I have only friendly dated and have a few close men now but those men just as great friends but none I would really want to marry.

"There are two - men in the "T" unit I would consider to maybe marry but one is already married. I think that is it so far."

"Thanks for sharing all that with me. I know who that one man is and I won't tell anyone." They don't visit any more for a long time.

On team # 1 E (5) Marine SSgt. Roland Jenkins (male) and Team # 1 F (6) Army Pfc. Angela (Angel Sandy) Sandra Holliday (female). "Sandy, okay if I call you Sandy?" As he glances over at her. She nods back yes. "Well, things are quit. May I ask you a very personal question?" Sandy nods back yes. "I know people in our "T" unit don't lie. That includes our 3 - missions Air Force and Army Chiefs who come in from Denver. You don't have to tell me. But I am trying to just figure it out.

"In your first time in high school and first year in college you had sex with over or maybe about 70 men. Then you were an Angel and then you went back to your last year of high school and then went a year in college all over again but then you are back to be a virgin? Do I understand that right?" Roland asked.

"You are trying to just figure it out, what do you think I went through with me trying to figure all that out, just me being an Angle, well, for a while and then me back in my own life like I am back now two - years in my life like it didn't even happen, then I find out I am back to me as a virgin. Yes, I had a lot of sex with a lot of men. I went through my last year of high school and a year of college two - times, that is four years but really in only two years.

"Then I find out I didn't have any sex with any men, not one man." They don't visit any more for a long time, like for over 20 - minutes.

"Okay, okay, I got tangled up with some real satan worshippers, really White Witches only I didn't know at that time they were satan witches. I was told they were disciples of Jesus. All of that was lies told to me. I even had a white light spirit guide only later, I found out he was really a satan false light. I was in college and felt and thought I was now worthless. So, I started to party a lot. And I left one bad group and went right into another kind of bad group, in with the doing the heavy drinking and drugs and a sex group. I was drunk or drugged up and I went to many open sex orgies and I let a lot of men have me because I really didn't care. Why? Mainly, because my grandpa and with my strong Church up – brining and I then I find out I am really working not for Jesus but am working for satan. I was really working in the enemy camp; how could God ever forgive me when I am so worthless. I switched camps, to the other camp that were not of God, either, I guess I was in my life committing spiritual suicide.

"Nothing I could do now; I was doomed to hell. My virginity I was saving for my husband just wasn't to ever be, so why not, I had sex, I just didn't really care anymore.

"I was drunk or I was high on drugs and I had nor have no memory of any of the many first times of me having sex. I was asked by a girl close friend about me getting STDs. She told me, I would have terrible death as I knew I was going to hell anyway.

"Then a drunken driver of a big heavy loaded truck ran over me. I was in a coma in a hospital for over four months. I was taken up to heaven by an Angle. I done my Angel task for God as you heard that part of my story from Chief James.

"I got my body back and in a flash, I was back in high school and then a drunken driver of a big loaded truck ran over me. I was in a coma in a hospital for months. When I came out of my coma I had broken legs, hips, ribs, arms and in a week, then I had no broken anything but maybe only in my mind. Many who had NDE told me that is what I had – ah, I had an NDE (Near Death Experience) but no one I could find even one who got two - years back to do over again but me. Mine was different than what they had." She didn't visit with him for a long time.

"Then my last year in high school I seemed to know who was having sex or that the boys dating me as it was really only sex is all he and they really wanted. My year in collage also I knew and I didn't know where I wanted to really do or go.

"Only that I had to find myself. I joined the Army. A year and two - months later and here I am, right here in the USAF 'T" unit. I haven't really dated any while I have been in the Army." They don't visit any more for a long time.

Even though no man knows the day or the hour that Jesus will return; HE will return for HIS uncompromising remnant Church. For some of us HIS return isn't on any particular date but on the day, we meet our unexpected end here on earth. Are you ready to meet with Jesus?

On team # 1 G (7) Air Force SSgt. Paula McGill (female) and Team # 1 H (8) Army Pvt2. Henry Norman (male). "May I ask you something Paula, things are quit," Henry asked. Paula nods yes. "You going to re - up in the Air Force?" Paula nods yes. "How do you think it would be – being married and still being in the "T" unit?"

"Is that a proposal?" (Paula knows about Henry and airman A1C Joyce.) Henry nods no. "Okay then it is just a question. Chief Scott does okay with that. Our boss the Col. does okay with that. Have you asked her?" Henry nods no. "Okay you two - want each other. That is great. Two - people in love. Have you prayed about you and her?" Henry nods yes. "You have not got God's answer back as yet." Henry nods no.

"Well keep on asking in prayer and soon you will know. I know you know what true love really is. Does airman Joyce feel the same about you?"

"I think so."

"You just think so. You should know that for sure. Joyce even kind of glows when she is at the "T" unit with you. Not only me but all the "T" women can see it and they know Joyce loves you and I would say she loves you a lot. Us women have talked about you - two. We all think you two - match up just great. Have you started to be prepared to be a husband? Have you started to be prepared to be a father to your children?"

"Wow. I just love you guys from our "T" unit, you guys get right down into the heart of any matter. No, I have not considered that.

"Joyce and I need to talk more about me being her husband and our children, you know, talk about that stuff. We have talked about having children, some." They don't visit any more for a few minutes time.

(Team man # 1 G is:) Paula (a woman) (What do you think they talk more about?)

(Team man # 1 H is:) Henry (a man) (What do you think they talk more about?)

On team SP # 1 is (sniper): Marine Cpl. Booker Parks (male) with SP Spotter Cpl. Ray Blackwood (male). "Say - Booker. The "T" unit is the best thing that has ever happened to me, to you too?" Ray asked.

"No. It is me finding the true Jesus for me. And then Chief James, Jay A. and Jay C. and following that is the rest of you bubble heads as I mean that in a great way, not in any bad way. When I went home for that week. I rented a real nice new big black shinny four - door sedan car. I took my grandma Mel and Pop (grandpa) and yeah, also the young woman Ester from down the street that is saving herself for me out for a big steak dinner on me. That took over three - hours, with Mel and Pop with their false teeth that took some time. Grandma Mel was just so very proud of me. Kind of shocked her that I could even really drive a car. Not many in the project can even drive one, not alone have a car.

"I got there not long after lunch. I visited three - of the local project gang boys hang outs. I really pushed it hard on those boys in those gangs to get out ah those gangs and get right with Jesus and to get all the knowing and education they could. Some there were my friends with me back in high school. They all knew I was in the Vietnam war for a year and that I was in some hot VC gun fire fights and I came out okay from my visit back there before coming down here to this "T" unit. They all knew I have made good in the Marines and that I am a sniper. They all know about you too. I was a little concerned about parking that new car on the street in the project but no one even touched that new rental car. Ester was concerned about me, she asked me right in the middle of that great dinner if any women were in my life. So, I told her yeah, I am in love with about 20 of the greatest women there ever is in this world in the USAF "T" Army unit and they all loved me back too. She about chocked really good on that bite," Booker said.

"Well, she didn't kill you cause you is here, ah, well you came back all okay. Did you tell her or did you leave her thinking about that?" Ray asked.

"I told them all three - that I had no idea what love really was until I got in with the women and men in the USAF "T" unit, except of course from Mel and Pops loving me. But they raised me. I now really understand true love and what it really is to be a man.

"Ester sure didn't understand that part. Ester asked me if I had been with another woman besides her? Grandma jumped on her, "Child mind your manners, that is not any subject for this grand dinner table." I told them that there is some great white men and white women that I know for a fact really do love me.

"They love me so much they would die trying to save me on any of our mission. Mel asked me if that was for sure. I told Mel and all that is yes, I am sure and I would die protecting them too, yes, for any of them. Grandma Mel is looking right at me. Grandma I did die and I was Baptized and I was raised up with Jesus. Grandma Mel said so loud others around eating there heard, "Hal ah leu hula, Praise God." Mel is well pleased with me; she is being such a Godly and Church woman. I don't think Ester sure didn't understand that either. She asked for some time with me alone later. I did have a hard life but it is getting a lot better."

"I think you had a lot harder life growing up than I did. Mom is really proud of me. Me getting out of our low - income slums project. Boys still there I grew up with are now in gangs, don't work any real jobs and are all into drugs, bad killing gangs, and are in a lot of project gang shootings. I think our missions are even better and are safer than being on the streets back home. She tells me so back to me in her letters each week who all got shot and those who got killed. I really sense that it is great us being baptized together. You are my best man and will you be when I get married. Oh, and you will pay my way down to South America when you get married to her down there, right?"

"No. The Army Col. said he would pay for us both to come down if she tells me yes. I am going to ask for a few extra days to stay there coming back home after this mission. Like to stay here with me for a few more day. Maybe to train his men some more."

Ray's look back at Booker told him yes. They have worked together through that year in Vietnam and through enough mission to really know each other, they had better because their lives depend on that kind of relationship and all their combat training together.

He also knows that she has a close, just one - year younger, real close friend that is with her a lot. They both are really beautiful young women. "Yeah. Maybe we can set us up a double wedding. How can we work that out, with them being down in South America and we are to be living in the US?" They both look out at their fire zone and both are thinking.

"Yeah. I kind of did have a hard life growing up. My real dad died when I was only 2 - years of age. He was at the wrong place at the wrong time. He had just got a jump up in his work position and had a great pay raise in two - weeks, the next day coming home he was at 6:30 p.m. caught in the middle of a grand drug fire fight and was hit 3 - times by gun fire and he was killed.

"I had a 6 - month - old new sister and a two - year - older brother but with mom's income gone we moved in with Grandma Mel and my Grandpa Pops, who are my mom's folks. Dad's folks lived far away somewhere. Mom worked two - jobs but with no good education other than high school she had low paying jobs. Mel and Pops mostly raised me. Mom had a few boy (or man) friends and when I was 12 - years - old, I was supposed to be up in my room dong my school studies but I was on the back porch, again. Over the last three - years I watch my mom have sex with a lot of different men out behind the house on a blanket.

"The last man was a big man pushing drugs both in the project and at the edge where outside the project cars would come stop and he would sell those drugs big time. He asked mom to marry him and they even had plans to build a big five - bed room house on that empty lot at the edge of the project right where he sold most of his drugs.

"Mom was really happy as I had seen her in years. He gave her money all the time so we had good food to eat and new clothes. Mom and he would sit out by the street curb and hold hands and while he would sell his drugs. A big gang only a few blocks away wanted his drug selling part and him out of their way, as I have been told. A car came by and shot them both, the Police report said they were hit with 57 - bullets, with both dead. Grandma Mel and Grandpa Pops raised me from then on. I really love these drug missions and I pray I am maybe just a small part of saving someone's mom from getting shot and Killed over any drugs somewhere in the US," Booker said. They don't visit any more for a long time.

On team #1 sniper: Booker Only back sniper man. (What do they talk more about?)

On team #1 spotter: Ray Only back SP spotter man. (What do they talk more about?)

On team # 2 A (1) 82nd > Army SSgt. Steve Clement (male) and Team # 2 B (2) USAF A1C Jessie Rodgers (female). Things are quit all over their fire zone and this mission site for over 46 - hours. "Steve. May I ask you a very personal question?" He turns his head toward her and he nods yes. "You haven't talked about your broken leg being healed on that old Glider drug mission trip along the US border out in Calf. when you guys got those two - Mexican border jumpers. Are you still processing that, yeah know, God's healing touch?"

"As an Army SP I went to the Vietnam war for a year and came back for 16 - months and then went back to Vietnam for my second - time for another year. My wife at that time told me she was in total terror every day my second time to Vietnam." Jessie is wondering if he is avoiding talking about his leg with God's right away healing or he is going someplace with this? "As I guess you know, I have seen things no human person should ever have to even see. I have seen killings from our side kill other men from our side, I think in two cases. Oh, yeah, I saw a lot of VC killed and our men killed in the Vietnam war. I am not judging; I am just saying. I keep on telling myself I didn't really see those two - killings like I think I really saw them. Both times we were in hot firing VC war action. Anyway, a while after I got back my second trip as an Army SP I had, well we had a chance to go to jump school as an SP, and still be an Army SP (Sniper Protection sniper). My wife with me and two – kids now, a girl then a boy, as she said I have really lost "IT" this time. Now I am going to jump and break my dam neck and get myself really killed.

"She said, "That I couldn't get myself killed in the Vietnam war so I am just going out to kill myself jumping." They don't visit any more for a long time. Jessie will not now talk first because she feels Steve needs some more time to think.

"Three weeks later, I had to stay on post those three weeks, I got my jump certificate on Friday and I got home to our apartment and found her note, keys and my divorce papers on the kitchen table. She and our Kids had moved back to Washington state, 3,000 miles away. I came out okay in the divorce, she didn't take me to the cleaners, as they say, but two - weeks later got a bill for \$1,800 for moving her out there.

"I got a letter from her, she basically said she will find a man who will take her and the kids and will not be trying to get himself killed all the time. She just couldn't handle me in the Army. That happens to a lot of us as I hear.

"I was never close to God, well okay, yeah, every day and many times some days in Vietnam I was what people call a fox hole Christian. God save my ass, God get me out of this crap, God get me out of here okay and I will be your preacher and I get out of the Army, etc. I guess I believed it over there in the war at that time but now, I know that I am not sure just what that really was. I didn't know God and I had no idea who Jesus was. I know now that I was lost. Then I drank to kill the pain that I had failed the woman I loved and my kids. I had mostly working women live with me for a week or a month. Then when I found someone else would ask her to leave so another woman could move in with me. For me they were all sexually great, well maybe except for one or two." Jessie knows Steve need to get this out of him. Jessie senses she is blessed to get teamed up with Steve on this mission.

"I did my Army job great but it was after duty time when I drank and really chased women, well really those women's skirts and what is in those skirts as the three Chiefs say. I got on that old Glider drug mission trip with the "T" unit to buddy jump along the US border with you guys. The night before I went to the NCO Club and got drunk again." They don't visit any more for a long time. Jessie will not talk first again because she feels Steve needs some more time to think about this down in his heart.

A bit later. "Did you know that?" Steve asked.

"Yes. Mike or Keith told us. You stumbled in the hall and kicked the trash can. But you were okay when you loaded up to jump for the mission."

"Okay. We were buddy jumping, I released my double buddy and the wind got my chute and pulled me back and I banged a big rock real hard and that broke my leg. They got me off the rock and with me moved over and leaning on my back pack. They splinted up my leg and then they went on the mission. I really felt so stupid getting my leg broke. They were gone for maybe a bit over two - hours. I heard them on the radio on my ear phone. I even heard that M-60 chopping up that shack. I was sure we had lost two - people. I was there most of the time really beating myself up in my mind. And I was in a lot of leg pain even with the two - shots. It didn't seem long and they are back with a US Border Patrol woman, that is Betty and the two - fence jumpers.

"Those four "T" people and the two - young Mexicans got right down on their knees by me, then go on putting their hands on me and they are praying for my leg.

"I have never seen anyone pray for anyone like they did. I sure wasn't expecting for God to heal my leg any. My leg got all buzzy inside and I got little electoral shocks all through my leg. I saw, as I am sure they did, I really saw my leg bone go right back into my leg and all my pain left." Steve stops for a few minutes.

"I knew, yeah, I just knew that I did not in any way deserve any healing, epically any healing from God. Inside I was really in shocked over this. I don't think I even said one word until after I got off the choppers.

"All I have said about women not being in the military I was sure Jay A. and Jay C. would rather cut my ball off rather than be saying any loving prayer for me. They said a loving healing prayer for me. And their God healed my broken leg better than new. You have been on missions with them. They both do things I would never believe if I wasn't there." As Steve looks over, Jessie just nodded back yes. Steve stops for a few minutes.

"Both Jay A. and Jay C. really jumped me about not liking any women in the military right in front of our two - Army 82nd Air Born women. All you women in this unit have really changed my mind about all women being in the military." Steve stops for a few minutes.

On team # 2 A (1) is: Steve (man) (What do you think they talk more about?)

On team # 2 B (2) is: Jessie (woman) (What do you think they talk more about?)

On team # 2 C (3) 82nd > Army SSgt. Fred Buckley (male) and Team # 2 D (4) Army Pfc. Lori Gross (female). Things are quit. "Lori. As a woman in the "T" unit what is your take from a young woman's view of the "T" unit and missions you have been on?" Fred asked Lori.

"I joined the Army because I have three - older sisters. I have a lot of relatives and cousins who have given some years back for and to our Country. I wanted to help keep and make better our great US. I soon hope to make Cpl. I have been in the Army now just at two years and guys and gals were talking about this new Special Forces unit and I applied. Most of the gals told me I was nuts. I would get into those bad drug fights and I would get hurt. Hurt bad. The unofficial roomer was it was a new unit is to go after bad drug people. If I could help keep drugs away from any kids which I plan a bit later to have, I am in. I never thought I would ever get this unit. Not many even applied. Then, I got here.

"We trained a lot more than we did in basic and then had a unit vote. These people wanted me to work with them, wow what love I have got back from these people plus a lot of black and bruised places on my whole body. I have never before found the brotherly and sisterly love as I have in this unit. I have one more year, but since the vote, I am thinking to re - up but only if I can stay in this unit.

"I am sorry, I got a little emotional there. I have been on a few missions now and as a woman I have the same opportunity as the guys here on these teams as I can do as well as the men do. I heard a lot of fire - fighting war stories from the guys in my past unit.

"I now have seen the differences between shooting to kill and shooting to only save our asses. This team only shots to hurt or kill only to save our team's ass. The bad cartel drug army men have seen real compassion and God's real love from this team and from the South American Special Forces Army Col and his men.

"I was right there when over 60 - of his 105 - men got baptized in that small horse tank. When we turn over those cartel drug army men, I know those men are mostly released in less than 10 - days. I have talked with some with Rita down there. Have I told you what you were looking for?" Lori asked.

"Yeah, and more. But as a woman and out here if you have to go potty out here with me being right here with you as a man. Are you concerned any about any others or me maybe seeing you?"

"That makes me remember. I now see that as it was really funny. We are like this but I was teamed my first time with another woman. I am doing my business and in my ear radio set come, "Click. A woman ahead of us is using white TP." I know it was me. I didn't think white TP would show where I was at. That thought me not to use white TP. Woman team mate asked me if the men saw me well enough to tell I was a woman or not. Yeah know, what really bothered me was it they saw where I was at more than maybe seeing me. I could have been shot with my pints down.

"No. I was on the mission when we got to free 609 naked women, a few naked very young kids and some naked men. They were every day walked around that part of town naked with a small choke chain around their necks and were made to give their sex to anyone who paid a few bucks just to screw those women right out on the grass right along the walk way out in front of everyone around. For those dirty men to sexually have a man's cum dump. They were less than just cheap whores. For over two - weeks those men and women felt so dirty they wouldn't even cover themselves up with the new clean robe we gave them. We marked each one with a number from 1 up to 609, more so for the women. We recorded their number and they each took over 47 showers each every day. Their self-value as a man or woman was way down below zero like being gone. When Chief James started to train us, as he did for days on how to get each one of their value and sexuality value back, I was ready to rebel as that is even against the Bible.

James asked me if I would do mouth to mouth resuscitation to a man or woman to put the breath of life back into them, I had to say yes. He had, well he got me do things I didn't even think I would ever do to my own husband after I get one or my husband ever do to me." Lori stops for a few minutes, they sit quit.

"Please Fred. I love these "T" unit people. I have learned more about a real relationship with God than I did with all my years in Church.

"I have learned more about myself. I have learned to love myself. That I really do have personal real value. And I have learned more about other people, both good and bad. I have learned more about my own value and the great value of all others. I don't want to give up what I have with these unit people. I think I am going for at least three - more years, well maybe four because I still have a year to go. Then if I find my husband to be then maybe I will get out of the Army. I plan on saving myself for my husband until then."

"Wow. Thanks for sharing that with me. You have any questions for me?" Fred asked Lori. They sit quit for a very long few minutes.

"It is really none of your businesses. But, yes, with a few. Okay. Why?"

"I am trying to work out sex for a man and for a woman like me. I have a man friend back home and just maybe I think he will ask me to marry him, soon. I am planning to be in the Army just for the next year like and then get out."

"I don't know what he does for a living but does he know what you are doing here in the Army. You must be woman worth a lot if he is willing to wait that long for you. What does he do." "He works with his dad building homes back in Indiana. We have talked a lot about life, marriage, having kids, men and women, a lot of things and he can build homes where ever. He has said he would come down here and find a building job. He says he is a virgin but I kind of have my doubts about that. He does go out and have dinner sometimes with a gal I know who stayed in our town a year behind me in high school. But only as friends."

"I have seen a lot of so - called strong men, even very strong married men cave in to sex when any woman flaunts herself with her lumps and bumps and lets a man know he may have her, her sex that is, like to have her body. I spent a year in Vietnam and for \$4 to a bar gal will give her sex to a GI. We had a lot of married men and they would just walk the streets close to a bar and get sex for only \$2 or \$3. They live over there on \$8 to \$10 a month. A lot of men brought back a bad sexual disease they never really wanted.

"They have infected a lot of women back here in the US and it is very people deadly, even more so than HIV. Is she a strong Church young woman?" He looks at Rain and she shacks her head no.

"Is she a good - looking young woman?" He looks at Rain and she shacks her head yes. "Well, there must be a good reason she doesn't want a man in her life. Are you concerned that he has had sex with her?" He looks at Rain and she shacks her head no. He looks back out at their field of fire zone.

"Ah, how do I say this. Ah, she is a man giving up a women's woman. She wanted to come in the Army with me and get her GED but the Army rejected her. The Army rejected her for the way she is physically." He looks at Rain.

"Do you really think we are doing any good out here, really?" Bob asked.

"Let me tell you a story. A man is walking along a beach, there are a lot of small dead crab shells all along this beach. He reaches down and picks up a live little crab, one of many thousands on this beach and he threw it way out, back into the water. What do you think?" Don asked.

"I think he was wasting his time. One out of many thousands."
